[8] - References:

- The ropes of death encircled me, flash floods of good-for-nothing men also kept terrifying me. (**Psalms 18:4**)
- And move on through Judah. He will actually flood and pass over. Up to the neck he will reach. And the outspreading of his wings must occur to fill the breadth of your land, O Immanuel! (**Isaiah 8:8**)
- Into vast waters those rowing you have brought you. The east wind itself **has** broken you in the heart of the open sea. (**Ezekiel 27:26**)
- And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah will be cut off, with nothing for himself. And the city and the holy place the people of a leader that is coming will bring to their ruin. And the end of it will be by the flood. And until the end there will be war, what is decided upon is desolations. (**Daniel 9:26**)
- The pronouncement against the wilderness of the sea! Like storm winds in the south in moving onward, from the wilderness it is coming, from a fear-inspiring land. (**Isaiah 21:1**)
- And here, now, there is coming a war chariot of men, with a span of steeds! And he began to speak up and say; She **has** fallen! **Babylon has** fallen, and all the graven images of her gods he **has** broken to the earth! (**Isaiah 21:9**)
- Bow and javelin they handle. They are cruel and will show no mercy. The sound of them is like the sea that is boisterous, and upon horses they will ride, set in array as one man for war against you, O daughter of **Babylon**. (**Jeremiah 50:42**)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **has** said; Here I am against you, O Tyre, and I will bring up against you many nations, just as the sea brings up its **waves**. (**Ezekiel 26:3**)
