Jeremiah 51:45... Get out of the midst of her, O my people, and provide each one his soul with escape from the burning anger of Yehowah.

[10] - References:

- Go forth, YOU people, out of Babylon! Run away from the Chaldeans. Tell forth even with the sound of a joyful cry, cause this to be heard. Make it to go forth to the extremity of the earth. Say; Yehowah has repurchased his servant Jacob. (Isaiah 48:20)
- Take YOUR flight out of the midst of Babylon, and go forth even out of the land of the Chaldeans, and become like the leading animals before the flock. (Jeremiah 50:8)
- Therefore get out from among them, and separate yourselves, says Yehowah, and quit touching the unclean thing, and I will take you in. (2 Corinthians 6:17)
- And I heard another voice out of heaven say; Get out of her, my people, if you do not want to share with her in her sins, and if you do not want to receive part of her plagues. (Revelation 18:4)
- And it came about that, as soon as they had brought them forth to the outskirts, he began to say; Escape for your soul! Do not look behind you and do not stand still in all the District! Escape to the mountainous region for fear you may be swept away! (Genesis 19:17)
- FLEE out of the midst of Babylon, and provide escape each one for his own soul. Do not be rendered inanimate through her error. For it is the time of vengeance belonging to Yehowah. There is treatment that he is paying back to her. (Jeremiah 51:6)
- Hey there, Zion! Make your escape, you who are dwelling with the daughter of Babylon. (Zechariah 2:7)
- Who is there knowing the strength of your anger and your fury according to the fear of you? (Psalms 90:11)
- That is why I shall cause heaven itself to become agitated, and the earth will rock out of its place at the fury of Yehowah of armies and at the day of his burning anger. (Isaiah 13:13)

Is it nothing to all you who are passing along the way? Look and see. Does there exist any pain like my pain that has been severely dealt out to me, with which Yehowah has caused grief in the day of his burning anger? (Lamentations 1:12)
