Jeremiah 51:50... You escapees from the sword, keep going. Do not stand still. From far away remember Yehowah, and may Jerusalem herself come up into your heart.

- Go forth, You people, out of Babylon! Run away from the Chaldeans. Tell forth even with the sound of a joyful cry, cause this to be heard. Make it to go forth to the extremity of the earth. Say; Yehowah has repurchased his servant Jacob. (Isaiah 48:20)
- And as for the ones escaping from the sword, they will return from the land of Egypt to the land of Judah, few in number, and all those of the remnant of Judah, who are coming into the land of Egypt to reside there as aliens, will certainly know whose word comes true, that from me or that from them. (Jeremiah 44:28)
- Take YOUR flight out of the midst of Babylon, and go forth even out of the land of the Chaldeans, and become like the leading animals before the flock. (Jeremiah 50:8)
- And I heard another voice out of heaven say; Get out of her, my people, if you do not want to share with her in her sins, and if you do not want to receive part of her plagues. (Revelation 18:4)
- And they will certainly confess their own error and the error of their fathers in their unfaithfulness when they behaved unfaithfully toward me, yes, even when they walked in opposition to me. (Leviticus 26:40)
- Whoever there is among You of all his people, may his God prove to be with him. So let him go up to Jerusalem, which is in Judah, and rebuild the house of Yehowah the God of Israel, he is the true God, which was in Jerusalem. (Ezra 1:3)
- If I should forget you, O Jerusalem, let my right hand be forgetful. (Psalms 137:5)
- And it came about that, as soon as they had brought them forth to the outskirts, he began to say; Escape for your soul! Do not look behind you and do not stand still in all the District! Escape to the mountainous region for fear you may be swept away! (Genesis 19:17)
