[7] - References:

- We lie down in our **shame**, and our humiliation keeps covering us, for it is toward **Yehowah** our God that we **have** sinned, we and our fathers from our youth on and down to this day, and we **have** not obeyed the voice of **Yehowah** our God. (**Jeremiah 3:25**)
- You set us as a **reproach** to our neighbors, a derision and jeering to those all around us. (**Psalms 44:13**)
- We **have** become a **reproach** to our neighbors, a derision and a jeering to those round about us. (**Psalms 79:4**)
- All day long my humiliation is in front of me, and the **shame** of my own face **has covered** me. (**Psalms 44:15**)
- O God, the nations **have come** into your inheritance, they **have** defiled your **holy** temple, they **have** laid Jerusalem in a heap of ruins. (**Psalms 79:1**)
- The adversary **has** spread out his own hand **against** all her desirable things. For she **has** seen nations that **have come** into her sanctuary, whom you commanded that they should not **come** into the congregation belonging to you. (**Lamentations 1:10**)
- And the statutes of Omri and all the work of the **house** of Ahab are observed, and **you** people walk in their counsels, to the end that I may make you an object of astonishment and her inhabitants something to be whistled at, and the **reproach** of peoples **you** men will bear. (**Micah 6:16**)
