Jeremiah 51:55... For Yehowah is despoiling Babylon, and he will certainly destroy out of her the great voice, and their waves will actually be boisterous like many waters. The noise of their voice will certainly be given out.

- And the sound of singers who accompany themselves on the harp and of musicians and of flutists and of trumpeters will never be heard in you again, and no craftsman of any trade will ever be found in you again, and no sound of a millstone will ever be heard in you again. (Revelation 18:22)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Tyre, and I will bring up against you many nations, just as the sea brings up its waves. (Ezekiel 26:3)
- And he says to me; The waters that you saw, where the harlot is sitting, mean peoples and crowds and nations and tongues. (Revelation 17:15)
- There is the sound of those fleeing and those escaping from the land of Babylon to tell out in Zion the vengeance of Yehowah our God, the vengeance for his temple. (Jeremiah 50:28)
