- Take **YOUR** flight **out** of the **midst** of **Babylon**, and go forth even **out** of the land of the Chaldeans, and become like the leading animals before the flock. (**Jeremiah 50:8**)
- And I heard another voice **out** of heaven say; Get **out** of her, my people, if **you** do not want to share with her in her sins, and if **you** do not want to receive part of her plagues. (**Revelation 18:4**)
- Hey there, Zion! Make your **escape**, you who are dwelling with the daughter of **Babylon**. (**Zechariah 2:7**)
- And his wife began to look around from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt. (**Genesis 19:26**)
- Then he spoke to the assembly, saying; Turn aside, please, from before the tents of these wicked men and do not touch anything that belongs to them, that **you** may not be swept away in all their sin. (**Numbers 16:26**)
- O God of acts of **vengeance**, **Yehowah**, O God of acts of **vengeance**, beam forth! (**Psalms 94:1**)
- And that day belongs to the Sovereign Lord, **Yehowah** of armies, the day of **vengeance** for avenging himself upon his adversaries. And the sword will certainly devour and satisfy itself and take its fill of their blood, for the Sovereign Lord, **Yehowah** of armies, has a sacrifice in the land of the north by the river Euphrates. (**Jeremiah 46:10**)
- Shout a war cry against her on every side. She has given her hand. Her pillars have fallen. Her walls have been torn down. For it is the **vengeance** of **Yehowah**. Take **YOUR** **vengeance** on her. Just as she has done, do to her. (**Jeremiah 50:15**)
- For even they themselves, many nations and great kings, have exploited them as servants, and I will repay them according to

- their activity and according to the work of their hands. (**Jeremiah 25:14**)
- Then the men said to Lot; Do you have anyone else here? Son-in-law and your sons and your daughters and all who are yours in the city, bring **out** of the place! (**Genesis 19:12**)
 - Shake yourself free from the dust, rise up, take a seat, O Jerusalem. Loosen for yourself the bands on your neck, O captive daughter of Zion. (**Isaiah 52:2**)
 - Get **out** of the **midst** of her, O my people, and **provide** each one his **soul** with **escape** from the burning anger of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 51:45**)
 - He was calling **out** loudly, and this is what he was saying; **CHOP** the tree down, and cut off its boughs. **SHAKE** off its foliage, and scatter its fruitage. Let the beast flee from under it, and the birds from its boughs. (**Daniel 4:14**)
