- **And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and was adorned with gold and precious stone and pearls and had in her hand a golden cup that was full of disgusting things and the unclean things of her fornication. (Revelation 17:4)**
- **With whom the kings of the earth committed fornication, whereas those who inhabit the earth were made drunk with the wine of her fornication. (Revelation 17:2)**
- **For because of the wine of the anger of her fornication all the nations have fallen victim, and the kings of the earth committed fornication with her, and the traveling merchants of the earth became rich due to the power of her shameless luxury. (Revelation 18:3)**
- **Because his judgments are true and righteous. For he has executed judgment upon the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication, and he has avenged the blood of his slaves at her hand. (Revelation 19:2)**
- **And they must drink and shake back and forth and act like crazed men because of the sword that I am sending among them. (Jeremiah 25:16)**
- **There is a devastation upon her waters, and they must be dried up. For it is a land of graven images, and because of their frightful visions they keep acting crazy. (Jeremiah 50:38)**
- **O how you have fallen from heaven, you shining one, son of the dawn! How you have been cut down to the earth, you who were disabling the nations! (Isaiah 14:12)**
- **Linger, you men, and be amazed, blind yourselves, and be blinded. They have become intoxicated, but not with wine, they**

have moved unsteadily, but not because of intoxicating liquor.
(**Isaiah 29:9**)

- For even they themselves, many **nations** and great kings, **have** exploited them as servants, and I will repay them according to their activity and according to the work of their hands. (**Jeremiah 25:14**)
- And I proceeded to take the **cup** out of the **hand** of **Yehowah** and to make all the **nations** drink to whom **Yehowah** had sent me. (**Jeremiah 25:17**)
- As regards that image, its head was of good gold, its breasts and its arms were of silver, its belly and its thighs were of copper. (**Daniel 2:32**)
- Because of this, at the same time as all the peoples were hearing the sound of the horn, the pipe, the zither, the triangular harp, the stringed instrument and all sorts of musical instruments, all the peoples, national groups and languages were falling down and worshiping the image of gold that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up. (**Daniel 3:7**)
- And another, a second angel, followed, saying; She **has** fallen! Babylon the Great **has** fallen, she who made all the **nations** drink of the **wine** of the anger of her fornication! (**Revelation 14:8**)
- Render to her even as she herself rendered, and do to her twice as much, yes, twice the number of the things she did, in the **cup** in which she put a mixture put twice as much of the mixture for her. (**Revelation 18:6**)
