Jeremiah 51:8" Suddenly Babylon has fallen, so that she is broken. Howl over her, you people. Take balsam for her pain. Perhaps she may be healed.

- And here, now, there is coming a war chariot of men, with a span of steeds! And he began to speak up and say; She has fallen!

 Babylon has fallen, and all the graven images of her gods he has broken to the earth! (Isaiah 21:9)
- But to you these two things will come suddenly, in one day; loss of children and widowhood. In their complete measure they must come upon you, for the abundance of your sorceries, for the full might of your spells, exceedingly. (Isaiah 47:9)
- For you yourselves know quite well that Yehowah's day is coming exactly as a thief in the night. (1 Thessalonians 5:2)
- And another, a second angel, followed, saying; She has fallen!
 Babylon the Great has fallen, she who made all the nations drink
 of the wine of the anger of her fornication! (Revelation 14:8)
- And he cried out with a strong voice, saying; She has fallen!
 Babylon the Great has fallen, and she has become a dwelling
 place of demons and a lurking place of every unclean exhalation
 and a lurking place of every unclean and hated bird! (Revelation
 18:2)
- Moab has been put to shame, for she has been struck with terror.
 Howl and cry out. Tell in Arnon, O men, that Moab has been despoiled. (Jeremiah 48:20)
- And the kings of the earth who committed fornication with her and lived in shameless luxury will weep and beat themselves in grief over her, when they look at the smoke from the burning of her. (Revelation 18:9)
- Is there no balsam in Gilead? Or is there no healer there? Why is it, then, that the recuperation of the daughter of my people has not come up? (Jeremiah 8:22)
- Go up to Gilead and get some balsam, O virgin daughter of Egypt. In vain you have multiplied the means of healing. There is no mending for you. (Jeremiah 46:11)

- Tell it among the nations and publish it. And lift up a signal, publish it. Hide nothing, O men. Say, Babylon has been captured. Bel has been put to shame. Merodach has become terrified. Her images have been put to shame. Her dungy idols have become terrified. (Jeremiah 50:2)
- I have laid a snare for you and you have also been caught, O Babylon, and you yourself did not know it. You were found and also taken hold of, for it was against Yehowah that you excited yourself. (Jeremiah 50:24)
- In that very night Belshazzar the Chaldean king was killed (Daniel 5:30)
- While they stand at a distance because of their fear of her torment and say, Too bad, too bad, you great city, Babylon you strong city, because in one hour your judgment has arrived! (Revelation 18:10)
