Jeremiah 52:11" And the eyes of Zedekiah he blinded, after which the king of Babylon bound him with copper fetters and brought him to Babylon and put him in the house of custody until the day of his death.

- And I shall certainly spread my net over him, and he must be caught in my hunting net, and I will bring him to Babylon, to the land of the Chaldeans, but it he will not see, and there he will die. (Ezekiel 12:13)
- And Zedekiah's sons they slaughtered before his eyes, and Zedekiah's eyes he blinded, after which he bound him with copper fetters and brought him to Babylon. (2 Kings 25:7)
- And the eyes of Zedekiah he blinded, after which he bound him with copper fetters, in order to bring him to Babylon. (Jeremiah 39:7)
- He has blocked me up as with a stone wall, that I may not go forth. He has made my copper fetters heavy. (Lamentations 3:7)
- And you must bring out your luggage like luggage for exile in the daytime before their eyes, and you yourself will go out in the evening before their eyes like those being brought forth for exile. (Ezekiel 12:4)
- As I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, in the place of the king who put in as king the one that despised his oath and that broke his covenant, with him in the midst of Babylon he will die. (Ezekiel 17:16)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Remove the turban, and lift off the crown. This will not be the same. Put on high even what is low, and bring low even the high one. (Ezekiel 21:26)
- I proceeded to give you a king in my anger, and I shall take him away in my fury. (Hosea 13:11)
