

Jeremiah 52:19 And the basins and the fire holders and the bowls and the cans and the lampstands and the cups and the bowls that were of genuine gold, and those that were of genuine silver, the chief of the bodyguard took.

[14] - References:

- And he proceeded to make ten basins of copper. Forty bath measures were what each basin would contain. Each basin was four cubits. There was one basin upon each carriage for the ten carriages. (**1 Kings 7:38**)
- And the extinguishers and the **bowls** and the **cups** and the **fire holders**, of pure **gold**, and the entrance of the house, its inner doors for the Most Holy and the doors of the house of the temple, of **gold**. (**2 Chronicles 4:22**)
- And the **lampstands**, five to the right and five to the left before the innermost room, of pure **gold**, and the blossoms and the lamps and the snuffers, of **gold**. (**1 Kings 7:49**)
- And as soon as they had finished they brought before the king and Jehoiada the rest of the money, and they proceeded to make utensils for the house of Yehowah, utensils for the ministry and for making offerings and **cups** and utensils of **gold** and of **silver**, and they came to be offerers of burnt sacrifices in the house of Yehowah constantly all the days of Jehoiada. (**2 Chronicles 24:14**)
- And the **chief** of the **bodyguard** took the **fire holders** and the **bowls** that were of **genuine gold** and those that were of **genuine silver**. (**2 Kings 25:15**)
- And the rest of the people that were left behind in the city and the deserters that had gone over to the king of Babylon and the rest of the crowd Nebuzaradan the **chief** of the **bodyguard** took into exile. (**2 Kings 25:11**)
- And all the utensils, great and small, of the house of the true God and the treasures of the house of Yehowah and the treasures of the king and of his princes, everything he brought to Babylon. (**2 Chronicles 36:18**)

- After that he made the utensils that are upon the table, its dishes and its **cups** and its **bowls** and its pitchers with which libations would be poured, out of pure **gold**. (**Exodus 37:16**)
- Upon the lampstand of pure **gold** he should set the lamps in order before Yehowah constantly. (**Leviticus 24:4**)
- And the **cans** and the shovels and the forks and all their utensils Hiram-abiv made for King Solomon for the house of Yehowah, of polished copper. (**2 Chronicles 4:16**)
- And also the **gold** and **silver** vessels of the house of God that Nebuchadnezzar had taken out of the temple, which was in Jerusalem, and brought to the temple of Babylon, these Cyrus the king **took** out of the temple of Babylon, and they were given to Sheshbazzar, the name of the one whom he made governor. (**Ezra 5:14**)
- And also let the **gold** and **silver** vessels of the house of God that Nebuchadnezzar **took** out of the temple that was in Jerusalem and brought to Babylon be returned, that they may reach the temple that is in Jerusalem at its place and be deposited in the house of God. (**Ezra 6:5**)
- The adversary has spread out his own hand against all her desirable things. For she has seen nations that have come into her sanctuary, whom you commanded that they should not come into the congregation belonging to you. (**Lamentations 1:10**)
- Belshazzar, under the influence of the wine, said to bring in the vessels of **gold** and of **silver** that Nebuchadnezzar his father had taken away from the temple that was in Jerusalem, that from them the king and his grandees, his concubines and his secondary wives might drink. (**Daniel 5:2**)
