

**Jeremiah 52:21**· And as regards the pillars, eighteen cubits<sup>1</sup> in height was each pillar, and a thread of twelve cubits itself would go around it, and its thickness was four fingerbreadths,<sup>2</sup> it being hollow.

**Footnote:** A cubit equaled 44.5 centimeters (17.5 inches)

**Footnote:** A fingerbreadth equaled 1.85 centimeters (0.72 inches)

- Eighteen cubits was the height of each pillar, and the capital upon it was of copper, and the height of the capital was three cubits, and the network and the pomegranates all around upon the capital, the whole of it, was copper, and the second pillar had the same as these upon the network. (2 Kings 25:17)
- Then he cast the two pillars of copper, eighteen cubits being the height of each pillar, and a string of twelve cubits would measure around each of the two pillars. (1 Kings 7:15)
- And its thickness was a handbreadth, and its brim was like the workmanship of the brim of a cup, a lily blossom. Two thousand bath measures were what it would contain. (1 Kings 7:26)
- For this is what Yehowah of armies has said concerning the pillars and concerning the sea and concerning the carriages and concerning the remainder of the utensils that are remaining over in this city. (Jeremiah 27:19)
