Jeremiah 52:24" Furthermore, the chief of the bodyguard took Seraiah the chief priest and Zephaniah the second priest and the three doorkeepers.

- All your dictators themselves have fled at one time. Without need of a bow they have been taken prisoner. All those of you who have been found have been taken prisoner together. Far off they had run away. (Isaiah 22:3)
- And King Zedekiah proceeded to send Jehucal the son of Shelemiah and Zephaniah the son of Maaseiah the priest to Jeremiah the prophet, saying; Pray, please, in our behalf to Yehowah our God. (Jeremiah 37:3)
- And he treats his booth violently like that in a garden. He has brought his festival to ruin. Yehowah has caused to be forgotten

in Zion festival and Sabbath, and in his angry denunciation he shows no respect for king and priest. (Lamentations 2:6)
