

Jeremiah 52:25 And from the city he took one court official that happened to be commissioner over the men of war, and seven men of those having access to the king,¹ who were found in the city, and the secretary of the chief of the army, the one mustering the people of the land,² and sixty men³ of the people of the land, who were found in the midst of the city.
