- And in the fifth month on the seventh day of the month, that is to say, the nineteenth year of King Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of **Babylon**, Nebuzaradan the **chief** of the **bodyguard**, the servant of the **king** of **Babylon**, came to Jerusalem. (**2 Kings 25:8**)
- And the rest of the people who were left remaining in the city, and the deserters that had fallen away to him, and the rest of the people who were left remaining Nebuzaradan the **chief** of the **bodyguard** took into exile to **Babylon**. (**Jeremiah 39:9**)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah from Yehowah after Nebuzaradan the **chief** of the **bodyguard** sent him from Ramah, when he **took** him while he was bound with handcuffs in the midst of all the exiles of Jerusalem and of Judah, who were being taken into exile in **Babylon**. (**Jeremiah 40:1**)
- And Nebuzaradan the **chief** of the **bodyguard** then **took** them and **conducted** them to the **king** of **Babylon** at **Riblah**. (**2 Kings 25:20**)
- And Pharaoh Nechoh got to put him in bonds at **Riblah** in the land of Hamath, to keep him from reigning in Jerusalem, and then imposed a fine upon the land of a hundred silver talents and a gold talent. (**2 Kings 23:33**)
- Then they seized the **king** and brought him up to the **king** of **Babylon** at **Riblah**, that they might pronounce a judicial decision upon him. (**2 Kings 25:6**)
- And a military force of the Chaldeans went chasing after them, and they got to overtake Zedekiah in the desert plains of Jericho. Then they **took** him and brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of **Babylon** at **Riblah** in the land of Hamath that he might pronounce upon him judicial decisions. (**Jeremiah 39:5**)
