- **Yehowah** will raise up against you a **nation far away**, from the end of the earth, just as an eagle pounces, a **nation whose** tongue you will not understand. (**Deuteronomy 28:49**)
- For here I **am** calling for all the families of the kingdoms of the north, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, and they will certainly come and place each one his throne at the entrance of the gates of Jerusalem, and against all her walls round about and against all the cities of Judah. (**Jeremiah 1:15**)
- Make mention of it, **you** people, yes, to the **nations**. Publish it against Jerusalem. Watchers are coming from a land **far away**, and they will let out their voice against the very cities of Judah. (**Jeremiah 4:16**)
- Here I **am** sending and I will take all the families of the north, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, even sending to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and I will bring them against this land and against its inhabitants and against all these **nations** round about, and I will devote them to destruction and make them an object of astonishment and something to whistle at and places devastated to time indefinite. (**Jeremiah 25:9**)
- And I will bring in the worst ones of the **nations**, and they will certainly take possession of their **houses**, and I will cause the pride of the strong ones to cease, and their sanctuaries must be profaned. (**Ezekiel 7:24**)
- For here I **am** raising up the Chaldeans, the **nation** bitter and impetuous, which is going to the wide-open places of earth in order to take possession of residences not belonging to it. (**Habakkuk 1:6**)

- And he has raised up a signal to a great **nation far away**, and he has whistled to it at the extremity of the earth, and, look! In haste it will swiftly come in. (**Isaiah 5:26**)
- For by those stammering with their lips and by a different tongue he will **speak** to this people. (**Isaiah 28:11**)
- No insolent people will you see, a people too deep in **language** to listen to, of a stammering tongue without your understanding. (**Isaiah 33:19**)
- Not to numerous peoples unintelligible in **language** or heavy in tongue, **whose** words you cannot **hear understandingly**. If it was to them that I had sent you, those very ones would listen to you. (**Ezekiel 3:6**)
- And I proceeded tempestuously to hurl them throughout all the **nations** that they had not known, and the land itself has been left desolate behind them, with no one passing through and with no one returning, and they proceeded to make the desirable land an object of astonishment. (**Zechariah 7:14**)
- In the Law it is written: With the tongues of foreigners and with the lips of strangers I will **speak** to this people, and yet not even then will they give heed to me, says Yehowah. (**1 Corinthians 14:21**)
