**Footnote:** Or, foreign gods Literally, a god [or, gods] of a foreign (country) Hebrew, 'elo·heh' ne·khar' The plural form of god may denote excellence

- Then they will have to say, It was because they abandoned the covenant of Yehowah the God of their forefathers, which he concluded with them when he brought them out of the land of Egypt. (Deuteronomy 29:25)
- And they will have to say, For the reason that they left Yehowah their God who had brought their forefathers out from the land of Egypt, and they proceeded to take hold of other gods and bow down to them and serve them. That is why Yehowah brought upon them all this calamity. (1 Kings 9:9)
- But you say, I have remained innocent. Surely his anger has turned back from me. Here I am entering into controversy with you on account of your saying, I have not sinned. (Jeremiah 2:35)
- And when you will say in your heart; Why is it that these things have befallen me? Because of the abundance of your error your skirts have been taken off as a cover, your heels have been treated violently. (Jeremiah 13:22)
- And it must occur that, when you tell to this people all these words and they actually say to you, On what account has Yehowah spoken against us all this great calamity, and what is our error and what is our sin with which we have sinned against Yehowah our God? (Jeremiah 16:10)
- And Yehowah will certainly scatter you among the peoples, and you will indeed be let remain few in number among the nations to which Yehowah will drive you away. (Deuteronomy 4:27)
- And you will have to serve your enemies whom Yehowah will send against you with hunger and thirst and nakedness and the

- want of everything, and he **will** certainly put an iron yoke upon your neck until he **has** annihilated you. (**Deuteronomy 28:48**)
- And they **will have** to **say**; It was for the reason that they **left Yehowah** the **God** of their forefathers who had brought them out of the **land** of Egypt, and they proceeded to take hold of other **gods** and bow down to them and **serve** them. That is why he brought upon them all this calamity. (**2 Chronicles 7:22**)
  - Because of **YOUR** overstepping the covenant of **Yehowah YOUR God** that he commanded **you**, and because **you have gone** and served other **gods** and bowed down to them. And Yehowah's anger **will** certainly blaze against **you**, and **you will** certainly perish in a hurry from off the good **land** that he **has** given **you**. (**Joshua 23:16**)
  - Look! We are today slaves, and as for the **land** that you gave to our forefathers to eat its fruitage and its good things, look! We are slaves upon it. (**Nehemiah 9:36**)
  - For this is **what Yehowah** of armies, the **God** of Israel, **has** said; A yoke of iron I **will** put upon the neck of all these nations, to **serve** Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and they **must serve** him. And even the wild beasts of the field I **will** give him. (**Jeremiah 28:14**)
  - Here I am keeping alert toward them for calamity and not for good, and all the men of Judah that are in the **land** of Egypt **will** certainly come to their finish by the sword and by the famine, until they cease to be. (**Jeremiah 44:27**)
