They have eyes, but they cannot see, they have ears, but they cannot hear.

- And yet Yehowah has not given you a heart to know and eyes to see and ears to hear down to this day. (Deuteronomy 29:4)
- For my people is foolish. Of me they have not taken note. They are unwise sons, and they are not those having understanding. Wise they are for doing bad, but for doing good they actually have no knowledge. (Jeremiah 4:22)
- We keep groping for the wall just like blind men, and like those without eyes we keep groping. We have stumbled at high noon just as in evening darkness, among the stout ones we are just like dead people. (Isaiah 59:10)
- And he went on to say; Go, and you must say to this people; Hear again and again, O men, but do not understand, and see again and again, but do not get any knowledge. (Isaiah 6:9)
- Son of man, in the midst of a rebellious house is where you are dwelling, that have eyes to see but they actually do not see, that have ears to hear but they actually do not hear, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 12:2)
- And Ephraim proves to be like a simpleminded dove without heart. To Egypt they have called, to Assyria they have gone. (Hosea 7:11)
- This is why I speak to them by the use of illustrations, because, looking, they look in vain, and hearing, they hear in vain, neither do they get the sense of it. (Matthew 13:13)
- Though having eyes, do you not see, and though having ears, do you not hear? And do you not remember. (Mark 8:18)
- Saying; Go to this people and say; By hearing, you will hear but by no means understand, and, looking, you will look but by no means see. (Acts of Apostles 28:26)

- They have not come to know, nor do they understand, because their eyes have been besmeared so as not to see, their heart so as to have no insight. (Isaiah 44:18)
- In order that, though looking, they may look and yet not see, and, though hearing, they may hear and yet not get the sense of it, nor ever turn back and forgiveness be given them. (Mark 4:12)
- Just as it is written: God has given them a spirit of deep sleep, eyes so as not to see and ears so as not to hear, down to this very day. (Romans 11:8)
