

**Jeremiah 5:24** But they have not said in their heart; Let us, now, fear Yehowah our God, the One who is giving the downpour and the autumn rain and the spring rain in its season, the One who guards even the prescribed weeks of the harvest for us.

[10] - References:

- Look! The eye of Yehowah is toward those fearing him, to those waiting for his loving-kindness. (Psalms 33:18)
- I also shall certainly give rain for YOUR land at its appointed time, autumn rain and spring rain, and you will indeed gather your grain and your sweet wine and your oil. (Deuteronomy 11:14)
- The One who is covering the heavens with clouds, the One preparing rain for the earth, the One making the mountains to sprout green grass. (Psalms 147:8)
- And, YOU sons of Zion, be joyful and rejoice in Yehowah YOUR God, for he will be bound to give YOU the autumn rain in right measure, and he will bring down upon YOU people a downpour, autumn rain and spring rain, as at the first. (Joel 2:23)
- Exercise patience, therefore, brothers, until the presence of the Lord. Look! The farmer keeps waiting for the precious fruit of the earth, exercising patience over it until he gets the early rain and the late rain. (James 5:7)
- For all the days the earth continues, seed sowing and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night, will never cease. (Genesis 8:22)
- However, Rizpah the daughter of Aiah took sackcloth and spread it for herself upon the rock from the start of harvest until water poured down upon them from the heavens, and she did not allow the fowls of the heavens to rest upon them by day nor the wild beasts of the field by night. (2 Samuel 21:10)
- Does there exist a father for the rain, or who gave birth to the dewdrops? (Job 38:28)
- So copious showers are withheld, and not even a spring rain has occurred. And the forehead of a wife committing prostitution is what has become yours. You have refused to feel humiliated. (Jeremiah 3:3)

- **Although, indeed, he did not leave himself without witness in that he did good, giving you rains from heaven and fruitful seasons, filling your hearts to the full with food and good cheer. (Acts of Apostles 14:17)**
