

Jeremiah 5:3

O Yehowah, are not those eyes of yours toward faithfulness? You have struck them, but they did not become ill. You exterminated them. They refused to take discipline. They made their faces harder than a crag. They refused to turn back.

[30] - References:

- For, as regards Yehowah, his **eyes** are roving about through all the earth to show his strength in behalf of those whose heart is complete **toward** him. You **have** acted foolishly respecting this, for from now on there will exist wars against you. (**2 Chronicles 16:9**)
- My **eyes** are upon the faithful ones of the earth, that they may dwell with me. The one walking in a faultless way, the it is who will minister to me. (**Psalms 101:6**)
- However, at the time that he was causing him distress, he acted unfaithfully still more **toward** Yehowah, that is, King Ahaz did. (**2 Chronicles 28:22**)
- Where else will **you** be **struck** still more, in that **you** add more revolt? The whole head is in a sick condition, and the whole heart is feeble. (**Isaiah 1:5**)
- And the people themselves **have** not returned to the One striking them, and Yehowah of armies they **have** not sought. (**Isaiah 9:13**)
- To no effect I **have struck YOUR** sons. No **discipline** did they **take**. **YOUR** sword has devoured **YOUR** prophets, like a lion that is causing ruin. (**Jeremiah 2:30**)
- Yehowah will cause the pestilence to cling to you until he has **exterminated** you from off the ground to which you are going to **take** possession of it. (**Deuteronomy 28:21**)
- Why, you, you **have** hated **discipline**, and you keep throwing my words behind you. (**Psalms 50:17**)
- Where else will **you** be **struck** still more, in that **you** add more revolt? The whole head is in a sick condition, and the whole heart is feeble. (**Isaiah 1:5**)

- So He kept pouring out upon him rage, his anger, and the strength of war. And it kept consuming him all around, but he took no note, and it kept blazing up against him, but he would lay nothing to heart. (**Isaiah 42:25**)
- And you must say to them; This is the nation whose people **have** not obeyed the voice of Yehowah its God, and **have** not taken **discipline**. Faithfulness has perished, and it has been cut off from their mouth. (**Jeremiah 7:28**)
- She did not listen to a voice, she did not accept **discipline**. In Yehowah she did not trust. To her God she did not draw near. (**Zephaniah 3:2**)
- A wicked man has put on a bold face, but the upright is the one that will firmly establish his ways. (**Proverbs 21:29**)
- But they kept refusing to pay attention, and they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their ears they **made** too unresponsive to hear. (**Zechariah 7:11**)
- But as for the house of Israel, they will not want to listen to you, for they are not wanting to listen to me, because all those of the house of Israel are hardheaded and hardhearted. (**Ezekiel 3:7**)
- Hence Pharaoh turned and went into his house, and he did not set his heart to **have** any regard for this either. (**Exodus 7:23**)
- Nevertheless, if with these things **you** do not let yourselves be corrected by me and **you** just **have** to walk in opposition to me. (**Leviticus 26:23**)
- And he went sending again a third chief of fifty and his fifty. But the third chief of fifty went up and came and bent down upon his knees in front of Elijah and began to implore favor of him and speak to him; Man of the true God, please let my soul and the soul of these fifty servants of yours be precious in your **eyes**. (**2 Kings 1:13**)
- In the multitude of your ways you **have** toiled. You **have** not said, It is hopeless! You **have** found a revival of your own power. That is why you **have** not grown sick. (**Isaiah 57:10**)
- Why is it that this people, Jerusalem, is unfaithful with an enduring unfaithfulness? They **have** taken hold of trickiness, they **have refused** to **turn back**. (**Jeremiah 8:5**)

- And I shall winnow them with a fork in the gates of the land. I shall certainly bereave them of children. I will destroy my people, since they **have** not turned **back** from their own ways. (**Jeremiah 15:7**)
- For an extermination has been **made**, and what of it if it is rejecting also the scepter? This will not continue existing, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 21:13**)
- Troubles! It has **made** one tired, but the great amount of its rust does not go forth from it. Into the fire with its rust! (**Ezekiel 24:12**)
- Just as it is written in the Law of Moses, all this calamity, it has come upon us, and we **have** not softened the face of Yehowah our God by turning **back** from our error and by showing insight into your trueness. (**Daniel 9:13**)
- And I also, for my part, gave **YOU** people cleanness of teeth in all **YOUR** cities and want of bread in all **YOUR** places, but **YOU** did not come **back** to me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Amos 4:6**)
- I **struck** **YOU** people with scorching and mildew. There was a multiplying of **YOUR** gardens and of **YOUR** vineyards, but **YOUR** fig trees and **YOUR** olive trees the caterpillar would devour, yet **YOU** did not come **back** to me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Amos 4:9**)
- I **struck** **YOU** people with scorching and with mildew and with hail, even all the work of **YOUR** hands, and there was no one with **YOU** turning to me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Haggai 2:17**)
- In reply the other rebuked him and said; Do you not fear God at all, now that you are in the same judgment? (**Luke 23:40**)
- But the rest of the men who were not killed by these plagues did not repent of the works of their hands, so that they should not worship the demons and the idols of gold and silver and copper and stone and wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk. (**Revelation 9:20**)
- Now the wild beast that I saw was like a leopard, but its feet were as those of a bear, and its mouth was as a lion's mouth. And the dragon gave to the beast its power and its throne and great authority. (**Revelation 13:2**)
