Jeremiah 6:15. Did they feel shame because it was something detestable that they had done? For one thing, they positively do not feel any shame, for another thing, they have not come to know even how to feel humiliated. Therefore they will fall among those who are falling, in the time that I must hold an accounting with them they will stumble, Yehowah has said.

- Did they feel shame because they had done even what was detestable? For one thing, they positively could not feel ashamed, for another thing, they did not know even how to feel humiliated. Therefore they will fall among those who are falling. In the time of their being given attention, they will stumble, Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 8:12)
- Yehowah was righteous in the midst of her, he would do no unrighteousness. Morning by morning he kept giving his own judicial decision. At daylight it did not prove lacking. But the unrighteous one was knowing no shame. (Zephaniah 3:5)
- So copious showers are withheld, and not even a spring rain has occurred. And the forehead of a wife committing prostitution is what has become yours. You have refused to feel humiliated. (Jeremiah 3:3)
- Therefore their way will become for them like slippery places in the gloom, into which they will be pushed and certainly fall. For I shall bring upon them a calamity, the year of their being given attention, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 23:12)
- And he himself came in and then stood by his master. Elisha now said to him; Where did you come from, Gehazi? But he said; Your servant did not go anywhere at all. (2 Kings 5:25)
- Foolish are those who make a derision of guilt, but among the upright ones there is agreement. (Proverbs 14:9)
- Here is the way of an adulterous woman. She has eaten and has wiped her mouth and she has said; I have committed no wrong. (Proverbs 30:20)
- Guard your feet whenever you go to the house of the true God, and let there be a drawing near to hear, rather than to give a

- sacrifice as the stupid ones do, for they are not aware of doing what is bad. (Ecclesiastes 5:1)
- At every head of the way you built your height and you began to make your prettiness something detestable and sprawl out your feet to every passerby and multiply your acts of prostitution. (Ezekiel 16:25)
- Do not you people let words drop. They let words drop. They will not let words drop concerning these things. Humiliations will not move away. (Micah 2:6)
- Gather yourselves together, yes, do the gathering, O nation not paling in shame. (Zephaniah 2:1)
