- The pronouncement against Dumah! To me there is one calling out from Seir; Watchman, what about the night? Watchman, what about the night? (**Isaiah 21:11**)
- And Yehowah sent to you all his servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them, but you did not listen, neither did you incline your ear to listen. (**Jeremiah 25:4**)
- Son of man, a watchman is what I have made you to the house of Israel, and you must hear from my mouth speech and you must warn them from me. (**Ezekiel 3:17**)
- At my guard post I will keep standing, and I will keep myself stationed upon the bulwark, and I shall keep watch, to see what he will speak by me and what I shall reply at the reproof of me. (**Habakkuk 2:1**)
- Call out full-throated, do not hold back. Raise your voice just like a horn, and tell my people their revolt, and the house of Jacob their sins. (**Isaiah 58:1**)
- But they kept refusing to pay attention, and they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their ears they made too unresponsive to hear. (**Zechariah 7:11**)
- For just as a belt clings to the hips of a man, so I caused the whole house of Israel and the whole house of Judah to cling even to me, is the utterance of Yehowah, in order to become to me a people and a name and a praise and something beautiful, but they did not obey. (**Jeremiah 13:11**)
- And the hearer actually hears the sound of the horn but he takes no warning at all, and a sword comes and takes him away, his own blood will come to be upon his own head. (**Ezekiel 33:4**)
