Jeremiah 6:20... What does this matter to me that you bring in even frankincense from Sheba and the good cane from the land far away? The whole burnt offerings of you people serve for no pleasure, and your very sacrifices have not been gratifying to me.

- Now the queen of Sheba was hearing the report about Solomon in connection with the name of Yehowah. So she came to test him with perplexing questions. (1 Kings 10:1)
- The heaving mass of camels itself will cover you, the young male camels of Midian and of Ephah. All those from Sheba, they will come. Gold and frankincense they will carry. And the praises of Yehowah they will announce. (Isaiah 60:6)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said, Add those whole burnt offerings of Yours to Your sacrifices and eat flesh. (Jeremiah 7:21)
- Of what benefit to me is the multitude of YOUR sacrifices? Says Yehowah. I have had enough of whole burnt offerings of rams and the fat of well-fed animals, and in the blood of young bulls and male lambs and he-goats I have taken no delight. (Isaiah 1:11)
- The one slaughtering the bull is as one striking down a man. The one sacrificing the sheep is as one breaking the neck of a dog. The one offering up a gift, the blood of a pig! The one presenting a memorial of frankincense is as one saying a blessing with uncanny words. They are also the ones that have chosen their own ways, and in their disgusting things their very soul has taken a delight. (Isaiah 66:3)
- I have hated, I have rejected YOUR festivals, and I shall not enjoy the smell of YOUR solemn assemblies. (Amos 5:21)
- As for you, take to yourself the choicest perfumes; myrrh in congealed drops five hundred units, and sweet cinnamon in half that amount, two hundred and fifty units, and sweet calamus two hundred and fifty units. (Exodus 30:23)

- The sacrifice of the wicked ones is something detestable to Yehowah, but the prayer of the upright ones is a pleasure to him. (Proverbs 15:8)
- The sacrifice of the wicked ones is something detestable. How much more so when one brings it along with loose conduct. (Proverbs 21:27)
- This is what Yehowah has said concerning this people; Thus they have loved to wander about, their feet they have not kept in check. So Yehowah himself has taken no pleasure in them. Now he will remember their error and will give attention to their sins. (Jeremiah 14:10)
- They will not continue pouring out wine to Yehowah. And their sacrifices will not be gratifying to him, they are like the bread of times of mourning to them, all those eating it will defile themselves. For their bread is for their own soul, it will not come into the house of Yehowah. (Hosea 9:4)
- And I will sell your sons and your daughters into the hand of the sons of Judah, and they must sell them to the men of Sheba, to a nation far away, for Yehowah himself has spoken it. (Joel 3:8)
- Who also is there among you that will shut the doors? And you men will not light my altar, for nothing. No delight do I have in you, Yehowah of armies has said, and in the gift offering from your hand I take no pleasure. (Malachi 1:10)
