

Jeremiah 6:8 **Be corrected, O Jerusalem, that my soul may not turn away disgusted from you, that I may not set you as a desolate waste, a land not inhabited.**

[10] - References:

- Take hold on discipline, do not let go. Safeguard it, for it itself is your life. (**Proverbs 4:13**)
- I said, Surely you will fear me, you will accept discipline, so that her dwelling might not be cut off, all that I must call to account against her. Truly they acted promptly in making all their dealings ruinous. (**Zephaniah 3:7**)
- And she went on uncovering her acts of prostitution and uncovering her nakedness, so that my **soul** turned **away disgusted** from company with her, just as my **soul** had turned **away disgusted** from company with her sister. (**Ezekiel 23:18**)
- For although they bring up their sons, I will also bereave them of children so that there will be no man, because, woe also to them when I **turn away** from them! (**Hosea 9:12**)
- At that time the **land** will pay off its Sabbaths all the days of its lying desolated, while **you** are in the **land** of **YOUR** enemies. At that time the **land** will keep Sabbath, as it must repay its Sabbaths. (**Leviticus 26:34**)
- Against him maned young lions roar, they have given out their voice. And they went making his **land** an object of astonishment. His own cities have been **set** afire, so that there is no inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 2:15**)
- And I will make **Jerusalem** piles of stones, the lair of jackals, and the cities of Judah I shall make a **desolate waste**, without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 9:11**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said, Go, and you must say to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of **Jerusalem**; Did **you** not continually receive exhortation to obey my words? Is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 35:13**)
- My ways he has disarranged, and he makes me lie fallow. He has made me one laid **desolate**. (**Lamentations 3:11**)

- **I shall without fail finish everything off the surface of the ground, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Zephaniah 1:2)**
