Jeremiah 6:8... Be corrected, O Jerusalem, that my soul may not turn away disgusted from you, that I may not set you as a desolate waste, a land not inhabited.

[10] - References:

- Take hold on discipline, do not let go. Safeguard it, for it itself is your life. (Proverbs 4:13)
- I said, Surely you will fear me, you will accept discipline, so that her dwelling might not be cut off, all that I must call to account against her. Truly they acted promptly in making all their dealings ruinous. (Zephaniah 3:7)
- And she went on uncovering her acts of prostitution and uncovering her nakedness, so that my soul turned away disgusted from company with her, just as my soul had turned away disgusted from company with her sister. (Ezekiel 23:18)
- For although they bring up their sons, I will also bereave them of children so that there will be no man, because, woe also to them when I turn away from them! (Hosea 9:12)
- At that time the land will pay off its Sabbaths all the days of its lying desolated, while you are in the land of your enemies. At that time the land will keep Sabbath, as it must repay its Sabbaths. (Leviticus 26:34)
- Against him maned young lions roar, they have given out their voice. And they went making his land an object of astonishment. His own cities have been set afire, so that there is no inhabitant. (Jeremiah 2:15)
- And I will make Jerusalem piles of stones, the lair of jackals, and the cities of Judah I shall make a desolate waste, without an inhabitant. (Jeremiah 9:11)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said, Go, and you must say to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem; Did you not continually receive exhortation to obey my words? Is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 35:13)
- My ways he has disarranged, and he makes me lie fallow. He has made me one laid desolate. (Lamentations 3:11)

I shall without fail finish everything off the surface of the ground, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Zephaniah 1:2)
