Jeremiah 7:10... And must you come and stand before me in this house upon which my name has been called, and must you say; We shall certainly be delivered, in the face of doing all these detestable things?

- And he built altars in the house of Yehowah, respecting which Yehowah had said; In Jerusalem I shall put my name. (2 Kings 21:4)
- Furthermore, he put the carved image that he had made in the house of the true God, respecting which God had said to David and to Solomon his son; In this house and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen out of all the tribes of Israel, I shall put my name to time indefinite. (2 Chronicles 33:7)
- And you yourselves turn around today and do what is upright in my eyes in proclaiming liberty each one to his companion, and you conclude a covenant before me in the house upon which my name has been called. (Jeremiah 34:15)
- Yehowah has said, Go serve each one of You his own dungy idols.

 And afterward if You are not listening to me, then my holy name You will no more profane by Your gifts and by Your dungy idols.

 (Ezekiel 20:39)
- And Eli was very old, and he had heard of all that his sons kept doing to all Israel and how they would lie down with the women that were serving at the entrance of the tent of meeting. (1 Samuel 2:22)
- And he further said to me; Go in and see the bad detestable things that they are doing here. (Ezekiel 8:9)
- Therefore say to them, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; With the blood you keep eating, and your eyes you keep lifting to your dungy idols, and blood you keep pouring out. So should you possess the land? (Ezekiel 33:25)
- Incline your ear, O my God, and hear. Do open your eyes and see our desolated conditions and the city that has been called by your name, for not according to our righteous acts are we letting

- our entreaties fall before you, but according to your many mercies. (Daniel 9:18)
- Judah has dealt treacherously, and a detestable thing has been committed in Israel and in Jerusalem, for Judah has profaned the holiness of Yehowah, which He has loved, and he has taken possession of the daughter of a foreign god as a bride. (Malachi 2:11)
