

Jeremiah 7:10 And must **you** come and stand before me in this house upon which my name has been called, and must **you** say; We shall certainly be delivered, in the face of doing all these detestable things?

[9] - References:

- And he built altars in the **house** of Yehowah, respecting which Yehowah had said; In Jerusalem I shall put my name. (**2 Kings 21:4**)
- Furthermore, he put the carved image that he had made in the **house** of the true God, respecting which God had said to David and to Solomon his son; In this **house** and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen out of all the tribes of Israel, I shall put my **name** to time indefinite. (**2 Chronicles 33:7**)
- And **you** yourselves turn around today and do what is upright in my eyes in proclaiming liberty each one to his companion, and **you** conclude a covenant **before** me in the **house** upon which my **name** has been **called**. (**Jeremiah 34:15**)
- And **you**, O **house** of Israel, this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **has** said, Go serve each one of **you** his own dungy idols. And afterward if **you** are not listening to me, then my holy **name** **you** will no more profane by **your** gifts and by **your** dungy idols. (**Ezekiel 20:39**)
- And Eli was very old, and he had heard of all that his sons kept **doing** to all Israel and how they would lie down with the women that were serving at the entrance of the tent of meeting. (**1 Samuel 2:22**)
- And he further said to me; Go in and see the bad **detestable things** that they are **doing** here. (**Ezekiel 8:9**)
- Therefore **say** to them, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **has** said; With the blood **you** keep eating, and **your** eyes **you** keep lifting to **your** dungy idols, and blood **you** keep pouring out. So should **you** possess the land? (**Ezekiel 33:25**)
- Incline your ear, O my God, and hear. Do open your eyes and see our desolated conditions and the city that **has** been **called** by your **name**, for not according to our righteous acts are we letting

our entreaties fall **before** you, but according to your many mercies. (**Daniel 9:18**)

- Judah **has** dealt treacherously, and a **detestable** thing **has** been committed in Israel and in Jerusalem, for Judah **has** profaned the holiness of Yehowah, which He **has** loved, and he **has** taken possession of the daughter of a foreign god as a bride. (**Malachi 2:11**)
