Jeremiah 7:12" However, Go, now, to my place that was in Shiloh, where I caused my name to reside at first, and see what I did to it because of the badness of my people Israel.

- Then all the assembly of the sons of Israel were congregated at Shiloh, and they proceeded to locate the tent of meeting there, as the land was now subdued before them. (Joshua 18:1)
- And they kept the carved image of Micah, which he had made, set up for themselves all the days that the house of the true God continued in Shiloh. (Judges 18:31)
- And that man went up out of his city from year to year to prostrate himself and to sacrifice to Yehowah of armies in Shiloh. And there is where the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were priests to Yehowah. (1 Samuel 1:3)
- But to the place that Yehowah Your God will choose out of all YOUR tribes to place his name there, to have it reside, YOU will seek, and there you must come. (Deuteronomy 12:5)
- And it must occur that the place that Yehowah Your God will choose to have his name reside there is where You will bring all about which I am commanding You, Your burnt offerings and Your sacrifices, Your tenth parts and the contribution of Your hand and every choice of Your vow offerings that You will vow to Yehowah. (Deuteronomy 12:11)
- And the ark of God itself was captured, and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, died. (1 Samuel 4:11)
- And he finally forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent in which he resided among earthling men. (Psalms 78:60)
- I will, in turn, make this house like that in Shiloh, and this city I shall make a malediction to all the nations of the earth.

 (Jeremiah 26:6)
- Why is it that you have prophesied in the name of Yehowah, saying, Like that in Shiloh is how this house will become, and this very city will be devastated so as to be without an inhabitant? And all the people kept congregating themselves about Jeremiah in the house of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 26:9)

- Cursed will you be in the city, and cursed will you be in the field.
 (Deuteronomy 28:16)
- These were the inheritances that Eleazar the priest and Joshua the son of Nun and the heads of the fathers of the tribes of the sons of Israel distributed as a possession by lot in Shiloh before Yehowah, at the entrance of the tent of meeting. So they left off from apportioning the land. (Joshua 19:51)
- So she said; Glory has gone away from Israel into exile, because the ark of the true God has been captured. (1 Samuel 4:22)
- And the wife of Jeroboam proceeded to do so. Consequently she rose up and went to Shiloh and came to the house of Ahijah. Now Ahijah himself was unable to see, for his eyes had set because of his age. (1 Kings 14:4)
- Let their walled camp become desolate, in their tents may there come to be no dweller. (Psalms 69:25)
- On account of all the badness of the sons of Israel and of the sons of Judah that they have done to offend me, they, their kings, their princes, their priests and their prophets, and the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem. (Jeremiah 32:32)
- Then there came men from Shechem, from Shiloh and from Samaria, eighty men with their beards shaved off and with their garments ripped apart and with cuts made upon themselves, and there were grain offering and frankincense in their hand to bring to the house of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 41:5)
