- Of **what** benefit to me is the multitude of **YOUR** sacrifices? Says **Yehowah**. I have had enough of **whole burnt offerings** of rams and the fat of well-fed animals, and in the blood of young bulls and male lambs and he-goats I have taken no delight. (**Isaiah 1:11**)
- What does this matter to me that you bring in even frankincense from Sheba and the good cane from the land far away? The **whole burnt offerings** of **you** people serve for no pleasure, and **YOUR** very **sacrifices** have not been gratifying to me. (**Jeremiah 6:20**)
- As my gift **sacrifices** they kept sacrificing **flesh**, and they kept eating **what Yehowah** himself took no pleasure in. Now he will remember their error and hold an accounting for their sins. To Egypt they themselves proceeded to return. (**Hosea 8:13**)
