Jeremiah 7:23... But this word I did express in command upon them, saying;
Obey my voice, and I will become your God, and you yourselves
will become my people, and you must walk in all the way that I
shall command you, in order that it may go well with you.

- And he went on to say; If you will strictly listen to the voice of Yehowah your God and will do what is right in his eyes and will indeed give ear to his commandments and keep all his regulations, I shall put none of the maladies upon you that I put upon the Egyptians, because I am Yehowah who is healing you. (Exodus 15:26)
- If you continue walking in my statutes and keeping my commandments and you do carry them out. (Leviticus 26:3)
- And you must listen, O Israel, and take care to do them, that it may go well with you and that you may become very many, just as Yehowah the God of your forefathers has promised you, as respects the land flowing with milk and honey. (Deuteronomy 6:3)
- Which I commanded Your forefathers in the day of my bringing them out of the land of Egypt, out of the furnace of iron, saying, Obey my voice, and You must do things according to all that I command You, and You will certainly become my people and I myself shall become Your God. (Jeremiah 11:4)
- And now if you will strictly obey my voice and will indeed keep my covenant, then you will certainly become my special property out of all other peoples, because the whole earth belongs to me. (Exodus 19:5)
- And I shall indeed walk in the midst of you and prove myself your God, and you, on your part, will prove yourselves my people. (Leviticus 26:12)
- In order by them to test Israel, whether they will be keepers of Yehowah's way by walking in it just as their fathers kept it, or not. (Judges 2:22)
- If only they would develop this heart of theirs to fear me and to keep all my commandments always, in order that it might go well with them and their sons to time indefinite! (Deuteronomy 5:29)

- When you are in sore straits and all these words have found you out at the close of the days, then you will have to return to Yehowah your God and to listen to his voice. (Deuteronomy 4:30)
- In all the way that Yehowah YOUR God has commanded YOU, YOU should walk, in order that YOU may live and it may be well with YOU and YOU may indeed lengthen YOUR days in the land of which YOU will take possession. (Deuteronomy 5:33)
- And now your kingdom will not last. Yehowah will certainly find for himself a man agreeable to his heart, and Yehowah will commission him as a leader over his people, because you did not keep what Yehowah commanded you. (1 Samuel 13:14)
- In turn Samuel said; Does Yehowah have as much delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in obeying the voice of Yehowah? Look! To obey is better than a sacrifice, to pay attention than the fat of rams. (1 Samuel 15:22)
- I shall make you have insight and instruct you in the way you should go. I will give advice with my eye upon you. (Psalms 32:8)
- You yourself have commandingly given your orders to be carefully kept. (Psalms 119:4)
- But Jeremiah said; They will do no such giving. Obey, please, the voice of Yehowah in what I am speaking to you, and it will go well with you, and your soul will continue to live. (Jeremiah 38:20)
- Whether good or bad, it is the voice of Yehowah our God to whom we are sending you that we shall obey, to the intent that it may go well with us because we obey the voice of Yehowah our God. (Jeremiah 42:6)
- And Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Jehozadak the High Priest, and all the remaining ones of the people began to listen to the voice of Yehowah their God, and to the words of Haggai the prophet, as Yehowah their God had sent him, and the people began to fear because of Yehowah. (Haggai 1:12)
- And those who are far away will come and actually build in the temple of Yehowah. And you people will have to know that Yehowah of armies himself has sent me to you. And it must

- occur, if you will without fail listen to the voice of Yehowah your God. (Zechariah 6:15)
- Circumcision does not mean a thing, and uncircumcision means not a thing, but observance of God's commandments does. (1
 Corinthians 7:19)
