Jeremiah 7:24. But they did not listen, neither did they incline their ear, but they went walking in the counsels in the stubbornness of their bad heart, so that they became backward in direction and not forward.

[29] - References:

- They have turned aside in a hurry from the way I have commanded them to go. They have made a molten statue of a calf for themselves and keep bowing down to it and sacrificing to it and saying, This is your God, O Israel, who led you up out of the land of Egypt. (Exodus 32:8)
- And they themselves, even our forefathers, acted presumptuously and proceeded to harden their neck, and they did not listen to your commandments. (Nehemiah 9:16)
- But my people has not listened to my voice, and Israel itself has not showed any willingness toward me. (Psalms 81:11)
- But they did not listen or incline their ear, but they kept walking each one in the stubbornness of their bad heart, and so I brought upon them all the words of this covenant that I commanded them to do, but that they did not do. (Jeremiah 11:8)
- And they began to rebel against me, and they did not consent to listen to me. The disgusting things of their eyes they did not individually throw away, and the dungy idols of Egypt they did not leave, so that I promised to pour out my rage upon them, in order to bring my anger to its finish upon them in the midst of the land of Egypt. (Ezekiel 20:8)
- And it must occur that when someone has heard the words of this oath, and he has blessed himself in his heart, saying, I shall come to have peace, although I shall walk in the stubbornness of my heart, with the intention of sweeping away the well-watered one along with the thirsty ones. (Deuteronomy 29:19)
- But this very people has come to have a stubborn and rebellious heart, they have turned aside and keep walking in their course. (Jeremiah 5:23)
- They are saying again and again to those who are disrespectful of me, Yehowah has spoken; Peace is what you people will come to have. And to every one walking in the stubbornness of his

- heart they have said; No calamity will come upon YOU people. (Jeremiah 23:17)
- But as for the house of Israel, they will not want to listen to you, for they are not wanting to listen to me, because all those of the house of Israel are hardheaded and hardhearted. (Ezekiel 3:7)
- For, like a stubborn cow, Israel has become stubborn. Is it now that Yehowah will shepherd them like a young ram in a roomy place? (Hosea 4:16)
- And their heart they set as an emery stone to keep from obeying the Law and the words that Yehowah of armies sent by his spirit, by means of the former prophets, so that there occurred great indignation on the part of Yehowah of armies. (Zechariah 7:12)
- However, they became disobedient and rebelled against you and kept casting your Law behind their back, and your own prophets they killed, who bore witness against them to bring them back to you, and they went on committing acts of great disrespect. (Nehemiah 9:26)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They have left Yehowah, they have treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they have turned backwards. (Isaiah 1:4)
- And they kept turning to me the back and not the face, though there was a teaching of them, a rising up early and teaching, but there were none of them listening to receive discipline. (Jeremiah 32:33)
- And all these maledictions will certainly come upon you and pursue you and overtake you until you have been annihilated, because you did not listen to the voice of Yehowah your God by keeping his commandments and his statutes that he commanded you. (Deuteronomy 28:45)
- And they should not become like their forefathers, a generation stubborn and rebellious, a generation who had not prepared their heart and whose spirit was not trustworthy with God. (Psalms 78:8)
- And so I let them go in the stubbornness of their heart, they went walking in their own counsels. (Psalms 81:12)

- And Yehowah proceeded to say to me in the days of Josiah the king; Have you seen what unfaithful Israel has done? She is going upon every high mountain and underneath every luxuriant tree, that she may commit prostitution there. (Jeremiah 3:6)
- But they kept on walking after the stubbornness of their heart and after the Baal images, about which their fathers had taught them. (Jeremiah 9:14)
- You yourself have deserted me, is the utterance of Yehowah.
  Backwards is the way you keep walking. And I shall stretch out
  my hand against you and bring you to ruin. I have got tired of
  feeling regret. (Jeremiah 15:6)
- And you yourselves have acted worse in your doing than your fathers, and here you are walking each one after the stubbornness of his bad heart in not obeying me. (Jeremiah 16:12)
- But they did not listen or incline their ear, and they proceeded to harden their neck in order not to hear and in order to receive no discipline. (Jeremiah 17:23)
- And they said; It is hopeless! For after our own thoughts we shall walk, and we are going to carry out each one the stubbornness of his bad heart. (Jeremiah 18:12)
- I spoke to you during your freedom from care. You said, I shall not obey. This has been your way since your youth, for you did not obey my voice. (Jeremiah 22:21)
- There has been a carrying out of the words of Jehonadab the son of Rechab, that he commanded his sons, to drink no wine, and they have drunk none down to this day, because they have obeyed the commandment of their forefather. And as for me, I have spoken to you men, rising up early and speaking, but you have not obeyed me. (Jeremiah 35:14)
- Yehowah Your God or anything with which he has sent me to You. (Jeremiah 42:21)
- Even it someone will bring to Assyria itself as a gift to a great king. Shame is what Ephraim himself will get, and Israel will be ashamed of its counsel. (Hosea 10:6)

- And the statutes of Omri and all the work of the house of Ahab are observed, and you people walk in their counsels, to the end that I may make you an object of astonishment and her inhabitants something to be whistled at, and the reproach of peoples you men will bear. (Micah 6:16)
- I know your deeds, look! I have set before you an opened door, which no one can shut, that you have a little power, and you kept my word and did not prove false to my name. (Revelation 3:8)
