

Jeremiah 7:26 But they did not listen to me, and they did not incline their ear, but they kept hardening their neck. They acted worse than their forefathers!**

[17] - References:

- And Yehowah **kept** speaking to Manasseh and his people, but they paid no attention. (**2 Chronicles 33:10**)
- But they did not listen or **incline** their **ear**, but they **kept** walking each one in the stubbornness of their bad heart, and so I brought upon them all the words of this covenant that I commanded them to do, but that they did not do. (**Jeremiah 11:8**)
- But they did not listen or **incline** their **ear**, and they proceeded to harden their **neck** in order not to hear and in order to receive no discipline. (**Jeremiah 17:23**)
- From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon, the king of Judah, and down to this day, these twenty-three years the word of Yehowah has occurred to me, and I **kept** speaking to **you** people, rising up early and speaking, but **you** did not listen. (**Jeremiah 25:3**)
- And they did not listen but **kept hardening** their **necks** like the **necks** of their **forefathers** that had not exercised faith in Yehowah their God. (**2 Kings 17:14**)
- So they refused to listen, and they did not remember your wonderful acts that you performed with them, but they hardened their **neck** and appointed a head to return to their servitude in Egypt. But you are a God of acts of forgiveness, gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abundant in loving-kindness, and you did not leave them. (**Nehemiah 9:17**)
- A man repeatedly reprov'd but making his **neck** hard will suddenly be broken, and that without healing. (**Proverbs 29:1**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am bringing upon this city and upon all its cities all the calamity that I have spoken against it, because they have hardened their **neck** in order not to obey my words. (**Jeremiah 19:15**)

- But according to your hardness and unrepentant heart you are storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath and of the revealing of God's righteous judgment. (**Romans 2:5**)
- But as respects Israel he says; All day long I have spread out my hands toward a people that is disobedient and talks back. (**Romans 10:21**)
- And **you** yourselves have **acted worse** in **your** doing than **your** fathers, and here **you** are walking each one after the stubbornness of his bad heart in not obeying me. (**Jeremiah 16:12**)
- And he did not humble himself because of Yehowah the same as Manasseh his father humbled himself, for Amon was one that made guiltiness increase. (**2 Chronicles 33:23**)
- Although you would bear witness against them to bring them back to your law, they themselves even **acted** presumptuously and did not listen to your commandments, and against your own judicial decisions they sinned, which, if a man will do, he must also live by means of them. And they **kept** giving a stubborn shoulder, and their **neck** they hardened, and they did not listen. (**Nehemiah 9:29**)
- To whom shall I speak and give warning, that they may hear? Look! Their **ear** is uncircumcised, so that they are unable to pay attention. Look! The very word of Yehowah has become to them a reproach, in which word they can take no delight. (**Jeremiah 6:10**)
- At the end of seven years **you** men should let go each one his brother, a Hebrew man, who came to be sold to you and who has served you six years, and you must let him go free from being with you. But **your forefathers** did not listen to me, neither did they **incline** their **ear**. (**Jeremiah 34:14**)
- But as for the house of Israel, they will not want to listen to you, for they are not wanting to listen to me, because all those of the house of Israel are hardheaded and hardhearted. (**Ezekiel 3:7**)
- Your loose conduct and your detestable things, you yourself must bear them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 16:58**)
