

Jeremiah 8:12 Did they feel shame because they had done even what was detestable? For one thing, they positively could not feel ashamed, for another thing, they did not know even how to feel humiliated. Therefore they will fall among those who are falling. In the time of their being given attention, they will stumble, Yehowah has said.

[11] - References:

- Did they **feel shame** because it was something **detestable** that they had done? For one thing, they **positively** do not **feel** any **shame**, for another thing, they have not come to **know even** how to **feel humiliated**. Therefore they **will fall among** those who are **falling**, in the time that I must hold an accounting with them they **will** stumble; **Yehowah has said**. (**Jeremiah 6:15**)
- So copious showers are withheld, and not **even** a spring rain **has** occurred. And the forehead of a wife committing prostitution is **what has** become yours. You have refused to **feel humiliated**. (**Jeremiah 3:3**)
- And their finish is destruction, and their god is their belly, and their glory consists in their **shame**, and they have their minds upon things on the earth. (**Philippians 3:19**)
- And **what will you** men do at the day of **being given attention** and at the ruin, when it comes from far away? Toward whom **will you** flee for assistance, and where **will you** leave **your** glory. (**Isaiah 10:3**)
- Therefore their way **will** become for them like slippery places in the gloom, into which they **will** be pushed and certainly fall. For I shall bring upon them a calamity, the year of their **being given** attention, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 23:12**)
- Vengeance is mine, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot **will** move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste. (**Deuteronomy 32:35**)
- And he used to say to them; Why do **you** keep doing things like these? For the things I am hearing about **you** from all the people are bad. (**1 Samuel 2:23**)

- And he did not humble himself because of **Yehowah** the same as Manasseh his father humbled himself, for Amon was one that made guiltiness increase. (**2 Chronicles 33:23**)
- Do not **you** people let words drop. They let words drop. They **will** not let words drop concerning these things. Humiliations **will** not move away. (**Micah 2:6**)
- **Yehowah** was righteous in the midst of her, he would do no unrighteousness. Morning by morning he kept giving his own judicial decision. At daylight it did not prove lacking. But the unrighteous one was knowing no **shame**. (**Zephaniah 3:5**)
- And **you** have **said**; On **what** account? On this account, that **Yehowah** himself **has** borne witness between you and the wife of your youth, with whom you yourself have dealt treacherously, although she is your partner and the wife of your covenant. (**Malachi 2:14**)
