[6] - References:

- **Woe to me on account of my breakdown! My stroke **has** become sickish. And I myself have said; Surely this is my sickness, and I shall carry it. (Jeremiah 10:19)**
- **That is why I have said; Turn **YOUR** gaze away from me. I will show bitterness in weeping. Do not **YOU** people insist on comforting me over the despoiling of the daughter of my people. (Isaiah 22:4)**
- **And you must say to them this word; Let my eyes run down with tears night and day and let them not keep still, for with a great crash the virgin daughter of my people **has** been broken, with an extremely sickish stroke. (Jeremiah 14:17)**
- **You have said; Woe, now, to me, for Yehowah **has** added grief to my pain! I have grown weary because of my sighing, and no resting-place have I found. (Jeremiah 45:3)**
- **May all their badness **come** before you, and deal severely with them, just as you have dealt severely with me on account of all my transgressions. For my sighs are many, and my **heart** is **ill**. (Lamentations 1:22)**
- **On this account our **heart has** become **ill**. On account of these things our eyes have grown dim. (Lamentations 5:17)**
