Jeremiah 8:18... A grief that is beyond curing has come up into me. My heart is ill.

- Woe to me on account of my breakdown! My stroke has become sickish. And I myself have said; Surely this is my sickness, and I shall carry it. (Jeremiah 10:19)
- That is why I have said; Turn YOUR gaze away from me. I will show bitterness in weeping. Do not YOU people insist on comforting me over the despoiling of the daughter of my people. (Isaiah 22:4)
- And you must say to them this word; Let my eyes run down with tears night and day and let them not keep still, for with a great crash the virgin daughter of my people has been broken, with an extremely sickish stroke. (Jeremiah 14:17)
- You have said; Woe, now, to me, for Yehowah has added grief to my pain! I have grown weary because of my sighing, and no resting-place have I found. (Jeremiah 45:3)
- May all their badness come before you, and deal severely with them, just as you have dealt severely with me on account of all my transgressions. For my sighs are many, and my heart is ill. (Lamentations 1:22)
- On this account our heart has become ill. On account of these things our eyes have grown dim. (Lamentations 5:17)
