Jeremiah 8:19... Here there is the sound of the cry for help of the daughter of my people from a land far away; Is Yehowah not in Zion? Or is her king not in her? Why is it that they have offended me with their graven images, with their vain foreign gods?

[9] - References:

- After that Isaiah the prophet came in to King Hezekiah and said to him; What did these men say, and from where did they proceed to come to you? So Hezekiah said; From a distant land they came to me, from Babylon. (Isaiah 39:3)
- Blessed out of Zion be Yehowah, who is residing in Jerusalem. Praise Yah, you people! (Psalms 135:21)
- Cry out shrilly and shout for joy, O you inhabitress of Zion, for great in the midst of you is the Holy One of Israel. (Isaiah 12:6)
- Yehowah will be king to time indefinite, your God, O Zion, for generation after generation. Praise Yah, You people! (Psalms 146:10)
- Let Israel rejoice in its grand Maker, the sons of Zion, let them be joyful in their King. (Psalms 149:2)
- For Yehowah is our Judge, Yehowah is our Statute-giver, Yehowah is our King, he himself will save us. (Isaiah 33:22)
- They, for their part, have incited me to jealousy with what is no god, They have vexed me with their vain idols. And I, for my part, shall incite them to jealousy with what is no people. With a stupid nation I shall offend them. (Deuteronomy 32:21)
- They are vanity, a work of mockery. In the time of their being given attention they will perish. (Jeremiah 51:18)
- Now why is it that you keep shouting loudly? Is there no king in you, or has your own counselor perished, so that pangs like those of a woman giving birth have grabbed hold of you? (Micah 4:9)
