

Jeremiah 8:2

And they will actually spread them out to the sun and to the moon and to all the army of the heavens that they have loved and that they have served and that they have walked after and that they have sought and that they have bowed down to. They will not be gathered, nor will they be buried. As manure upon the face of the ground they will become.

- And that you may not raise your eyes to the **heavens** and indeed see the **sun** and the **moon** and the stars, all the **army** of the **heavens**, and **actually** get seduced and bow **down** to them and serve them, which Yehowah your God has apportioned to all the peoples under the whole **heavens**. (**Deuteronomy 4:19**)
- And he should go and worship other gods and bow **down** to them or to the **sun** or the **moon** or all the **army** of the **heavens**, a thing that I **have** not commanded. (**Deuteronomy 17:3**)
- And they kept leaving all the commandments of Yehowah their God and proceeded to make for themselves molten statues, two calves, and to make a sacred pole, and they began to bow **down** to all the **army** of the **heavens** and to serve Baal. (**2 Kings 17:16**)
- So he built again the high places that Hezekiah his father had destroyed, and set up altars to Baal and made a sacred pole, just as Ahab the king of Israel had done, and he began to bow **down** to all the **army** of the **heavens** and to serve them. (**2 Kings 21:3**)
- Can there be stealing, murdering and committing adultery and swearing falsely and making sacrificial smoke to Baal and walking **after** other gods whom **you** had not known. (**Jeremiah 7:9**)
- And the houses of Jerusalem and the houses of the kings of Judah must become like the place of Topheth, unclean ones, that is, all the houses upon the roofs of which they made sacrificial smoke to all the **army** of the **heavens** and there was a pouring **out** of drink offerings to other gods. (**Jeremiah 19:13**)
- And those who are bowing **down** upon the roofs to the **army** of the **heavens**, and those who are bowing **down**, making sworn oaths to Yehowah and making sworn oaths by Malcam. (**Zephaniah 1:5**)

- And he put **out** of business the foreign-god priests, whom the kings of Judah had put in that they might make sacrificial smoke on the high places in the cities of Judah and the surroundings of Jerusalem, and also those making sacrificial smoke to Baal, to the **sun** and to the **moon** and to the constellations of the zodiac and to all the **army** of the **heavens**. (**2 Kings 23:5**)
- So he built again the high places that Hezekiah his father had pulled **down**, and set up altars to the Baals and made sacred poles, and he began to bow **down** to all the **army** of the **heavens** and serve them. (**2 Chronicles 33:3**)
- So he brought me to the inner courtyard of the house of Yehowah, and, look! at the entrance of the temple of Yehowah, between the porch and the altar, there were about twenty-five men with their backs to the temple of Yehowah and their **faces** to the east, and they were bowing **down** to the east, to the **sun**. (**Ezekiel 8:16**)
- So God turned and handed them over to render sacred service to the **army** of heaven, just as it is written in the book of the prophets, It was not to me that **you** offered victims and sacrifices for forty years in the wilderness, was it, O house of Israel? (**Acts of Apostles 7:42**)
- And the dead body of Jezebel **will** certainly become as **manure** upon the **face** of the field in the tract of land of Jezreel, that they may not say; This is Jezebel. (**2 Kings 9:37**)
- They were annihilated at En-dor, they became **manure** for the **ground**. (**Psalms 83:10**)
- Speak; This is what the utterance of Yehowah is; The dead bodies of mankind must also fall like **manure** upon the **face** of the field and like a row of newly cut grain **after** the reaper, with no one to do the gathering up. (**Jeremiah 9:22**)
- With deaths from maladies they **will** die. They **will** not be bewailed, neither **will** they be **buried**. As **manure** upon the surface of the **ground** they **will** become, and by the sword and by famine they **will** come to an end, and their dead bodies **will actually** serve as food for the flying creatures of the **heavens** and for the beasts of the earth. (**Jeremiah 16:4**)
- And those slain by Yehowah **will** certainly come to be in that day from one end of the earth clear to the other end of the earth.

- They **will** not be bewailed, neither **will** they be **gathered** up or be **buried**. As **manure** on the surface of the **ground** they **will** become. (**Jeremiah 25:33**)
- And he went on to build altars to all the **army** of the **heavens** in two courtyards of the house of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 21:5**)

 - Like his **manure** cakes he perishes forever; The very ones teeing him **will** say; Where is he? (**Job 20:7**)
 - That is why the anger of Yehowah has grown hot against his people, and he **will** stretch **out** his hand against them and strike them. And the mountains **will** be agitated, and their dead bodies **will** become like the offal in the midst of the streets. In view of all this his anger has not turned back, but his hand is stretched **out** still. (**Isaiah 5:25**)
 - You must also say to them, On account of the fact that **YOUR** fathers left me, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they kept going **after** other gods and serving them and bowing **down** to them. But me they left, and my Law they did not keep. (**Jeremiah 16:11**)
 - And I **will** put the carcasses of the sons of Israel before their dungy idols, and I **will** scatter **YOUR** bones all around **YOUR** altars. (**Ezekiel 6:5**)
 - And **you** people **will have** to know that I am Yehowah, when their slain ones come to be in the midst of their dungy idols, all around their altars, upon every high hill, on all the tops of the mountains and under every luxuriant tree and under every branchy big tree, the place where they **have** offered a restful odor to all their dungy idols. (**Ezekiel 6:13**)
 - Upon the surface of the field you **will** fall, for I myself **have** spoken, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 39:5**)
