Jeremiah 8:5... Why is it that this people, Jerusalem, is unfaithful with an enduring unfaithfulness? They have taken hold of trickiness, they have refused to turn back.

[10] - References:

- You have tossed away all those straying from your regulations, for their trickiness is falsehood. (Psalms 119:118)
- Your sitting is in the midst of deception. Through deception they have refused to know me, is the utterance of Yehowah.

 (Jeremiah 9:6)
- But if you people refuse and are actually rebellious, with a sword you will be eaten up, for the very mouth of Yehowah has spoken it. (Isaiah 1:20)
- O Yehowah, are not those eyes of yours toward faithfulness? You have struck them, but they did not become ill. You exterminated them. They refused to take discipline. They made their faces harder than a crag. They refused to turn back. (Jeremiah 5:3)
- And they themselves, during their kingdom and amid your abundant good things that you gave to them and in the broad and fat land that you made available for them, they did not serve you and did not turn back from their bad practices. (Nehemiah 9:35)
- And she proceeded to behave rebelliously against my judicial decisions in wickedness more than the nations, and against my statutes more than the lands that are all around her, for my judicial decisions they rejected and, as for my statutes, they did not walk in them. (Ezekiel 5:6)
- Therefore say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Come back and turn yourselves back from YOUR dungy idols and turn YOUR faces back even from all YOUR detestable things. (Ezekiel 14:6)
- And the pride of Israel has testified to his face, and they have not returned to Yehowah their God, nor have they looked for him because of all this. (Hosea 7:10)

- He will not return to the land of Egypt, but Assyria will be his king, because they refused to return. (Hosea 11:5)
- And my people are tending toward unfaithfulness to me. And upward they call it, no one at all does any rising up. (Hosea 11:7)
