

Jeremiah 9:11 • **And I will make Jerusalem piles of stones, the lair of jackals, and the cities of Judah I shall make a desolate waste, without an inhabitant.**

[25] - References:

- O God, the nations have come into your inheritance, they have defiled your holy temple, they have laid **Jerusalem** in a heap of ruins. (**Psalms 79:1**)
- For you have made a city a pile of **stones**, a fortified town a crumbling ruin, a dwelling tower of strangers to be no city, which will not be rebuilt even to time indefinite. (**Isaiah 25:2**)
- Micah of Moresheth himself happened to be prophesying in the days of Hezekiah the king of **Judah** and went on to say to all the people of **Judah**, This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Zion herself will be plowed up as a mere field, and **Jerusalem** herself will become mere heaps of ruins, and the mountain of the House will be for high places of a forest. (**Jeremiah 26:18**)
- And **jackals** must howl in her dwelling towers, and the big snake will be in the palaces of exquisite delight. And the season for her is near to come, and her days themselves will not be postponed. (**Isaiah 13:22**)
- Listen! A report! Here it has come, also a great pounding from the land of the north, in order to **make** the **cities** of **Judah** a **desolate waste**, the **lair** of **jackals**. (**Jeremiah 10:22**)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; A **desolate waste** is what the whole land will become, and shall I not carry out a sheer extermination? (**Jeremiah 4:27**)
- And all this land must become a devastated place, an object of astonishment, and these nations will have to serve the king of Babylon seventy years. (**Jeremiah 25:11**)
- And fields will certainly be bought in this land of which **you** people will be saying; It is a **desolate waste without** man and domestic animal. It has been given into the hand of the Chaldeans. (**Jeremiah 32:43**)

- And I, for my part, will lay the land **desolate**, and **YOUR** enemies who are dwelling in it will simply stare in amazement over it. (**Leviticus 26:32**)
- And **YOU** I shall scatter among the nations, and I will unsheathe a sword after **YOU**, and **YOUR** land must become a desolation, and **YOUR cities** will become a **desolate** ruin. (**Leviticus 26:33**)
- In the city an astonishing condition has been left behind, the gate has been crushed to a mere rubble heap. (**Isaiah 24:12**)
- And the heat-parched ground will have become as a reedy pool, and the thirsty ground as springs of water. In the abiding place of **jackals**, a resting-place for them, there will be green grass with reeds and papyrus plants. (**Isaiah 35:7**)
- For here I am calling for all the families of the kingdoms of the north, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they will certainly come and place each one his throne at the entrance of the gates of **Jerusalem**, and against all her walls round about and against all the **cities** of **Judah**. (**Jeremiah 1:15**)
- Against him maned young lions roar, they have given out their voice. And they went making his land an object of astonishment. His own **cities** have been set afire, so that there is no **inhabitant**. (**Jeremiah 2:15**)
- He has gone up as a lion out of his thicket, and the one who is bringing the nations to ruin has pulled away, he has gone forth from his place in order to render your land as an object of astonishment. Your own **cities** will fall in ruins so that there will be no **inhabitant**. (**Jeremiah 4:7**)
- Be corrected, O **Jerusalem**, that my soul may not turn away disgusted from you, that I may not set you as a **desolate waste**, a land not inhabited. (**Jeremiah 6:8**)
- One has made it a **desolate waste**, it has withered away, it is desolated to me. The whole land has been made **desolate**, because there is no man that has taken it to heart. (**Jeremiah 12:11**)
- Here I am commanding, is the utterance of Yehowah; and I shall certainly bring them back to this city, and they must fight against it and capture it and burn it with fire, and the **cities** of **Judah** I

- shall **make** a **desolate waste without** an **inhabitant**. (**Jeremiah 34:22**)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; **You** yourselves have seen all the calamity that I have brought in upon **Jerusalem** and upon all the **cities** of **Judah**, and here they are a devastated place this day, and in them there is no **inhabitant**. (**Jeremiah 44:2**)
 - And Hazor must become the **lair** of **jackals**, a **desolate waste** to time indefinite. No man will dwell there, and in her no son of mankind will reside as an alien. (**Jeremiah 49:33**)
 - Yehowah has accomplished his rage. He has poured out his burning anger. And he sets a fire ablaze in Zion, which eats up her foundations. (**Lamentations 4:11**)
 - On account of Zion's mountain that is desolated, foxes themselves have walked on it. (**Lamentations 5:18**)
 - And now she is planted in the wilderness, in a waterless and thirsty land. (**Ezekiel 19:13**)
 - And I shall actually **make** the land a **desolate waste**, even a desolation, and the pride of its strength must be made to cease and the mountains of Israel must be laid **desolate**, with no one passing through. (**Ezekiel 33:28**)
 - And they will have to know that I am Yehowah when I **make** the land a **desolate waste**, even a desolation, on account of all their detestable things that they have done. (**Ezekiel 33:29**)
