Jeremiah 9:14... But they kept on walking after the stubbornness of their heart and after the Baal images, about which their fathers had taught them.

[11] - References:

- In that time they will call Jerusalem the throne of Yehowah, and to her all the nations must be brought together to the name of Yehowah at Jerusalem, and they will no more walk after the stubbornness of their bad heart. (Jeremiah 3:17)
- But they did not listen, neither did they incline their ear, but they went walking in the counsels in the stubbornness of their bad heart, so that they became backward in direction and not forward. (Jeremiah 7:24)
- So the sons of Israel did what was bad in Yehowah's eyes, and they were forgetful of Yehowah their God and went serving the Baals and the sacred poles. (Judges 3:7)
- And they began to call to Yehowah for aid and say, We have sinned, for we have left Yehowah that we might serve the Baals and the Ashtoreth images, and now deliver us out of the hand of our enemies, that we may serve you. (1 Samuel 12:10)
- They called them. To that same extent they went away from before them. To the Baal images they took up sacrificing, and to the graven images they began making sacrificial smoke. (Hosea 11:2)
- But we shall positively do every word that has gone forth from our mouth, in order to make sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens and to pour out to her drink offerings, just as we ourselves and our forefathers, our kings and our princes did in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, when we used to be satisfied with bread and to be well off, and we did not see any calamity at all. (Jeremiah 44:17)
- And it must serve as a fringed edge for YOU, and YOU must see it and remember all the commandments of Yehowah and do them, and YOU must not go about following YOUR hearts and YOUR eyes, which YOU are following in immoral intercourse. (Numbers 15:39)

- But they did not listen or incline their ear, but they kept walking each one in the stubbornness of their bad heart, and so I brought upon them all the words of this covenant that I commanded them to do, but that they did not do. (Jeremiah 11:8)
- This bad people who are refusing to obey my words, who are walking in the stubbornness of their heart and who keep walking after other gods in order to serve them and to bow down to them, will also become just like this belt that is fit for nothing. (Jeremiah 13:10)
- And you yourselves have acted worse in your doing than your fathers, and here you are walking each one after the stubbornness of his bad heart in not obeying me. (Jeremiah 16:12)
- This is what Yehowah has said, On account of three revolts of Judah, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of their rejecting the Law of Yehowah, and because they did not keep his own regulations, but their lies, after which their forefathers had walked, kept making them wander. (Amos 2:4)
