Jeremiah 9:26... Upon Egypt and upon Judah and upon Edom and upon the sons of Ammon and upon Moab and upon all those with hair clipped at the temples who are dwelling in the wilderness, for all the nations are uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel are uncircumcised in heart.

- The pronouncement against Egypt; Look! Yehowah is riding on a swift cloud and coming into Egypt. And the valueless gods of Egypt will certainly quiver because of him, and the very heart of Egypt will melt in the midst of it. (Isaiah 19:1)
- Son of man, set your face against Pharaoh the king of Egypt and prophesy against him and against Egypt in its entirety. (Ezekiel 29:2)
- The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz that he visioned concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz and Hezekiah, kings of Judah. (Isaiah 1:1)
- And you must send them to the king of Edom and to the king of Moab and to the king of the sons of Ammon and to the king of Tyre and to the king of Sidon by the hand of the messengers who are coming to Jerusalem to Zedekiah the king of Judah. (Jeremiah 27:3)
- There is where Edom, her kings and all her chieftains are, who, in their mightiness, were put with those slain by the sword, they themselves will lie down even with the uncircumcised ones and with those going down into the pit. (Ezekiel 32:29)
- The vision of Obadiah; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said regarding Edom; There is a report that we have heard from Yehowah, and there is an envoy that has been sent among the nations, Rise up, You people, and let us rise up against her in battle. (Obadiah 1:1)
- For the sons of Ammon this is what Yehowah has said; Are there no sons that Israel has, or is there no inheritor that he has? Why is it that Malcam has taken possession of Gad, and his own people have taken up dwelling in Israel's very cities? (Jeremiah 49:1)

- Son of man, set your face toward the sons of Ammon and prophesy against them. (Ezekiel 25:2)
- The pronouncement against Moab; Because in the night it has been despoiled, Ar of Moab itself has been silenced. Because in the night it has been despoiled, Kir of Moab itself has been silenced. (Isaiah 15:1)
- For Moab this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Woe to Nebo, for she has been despoiled! Kiriathaim has been put to shame, has been captured. The secure height has been put to shame and been put in terror. (Jeremiah 48:1)
- And Dedan and Tema and Buz and all those with hair clipped at the temples. (Jeremiah 25:23)
- And their camels must become a plunder, and the multitude of their livestock a spoil. And I will scatter them to every wind, those who have their hair clipped at the temples, and from all regions near it I shall bring in their disaster, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 49:32)
- Yet I, for my part, proceeded to walk in opposition to them, and I had to bring them into the land of their enemies. Perhaps at that time their uncircumcised heart will be humbled, and at that time they will pay off their error. (Leviticus 26:41)
- And Yehowah your God will have to circumcise your heart and the heart of your offspring, that you may love Yehowah your God with all your heart and all your soul for the sake of your life. (Deuteronomy 30:6)
- Get yourselves circumcised to Yehowah, and take away the foreskins of Your hearts, You men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem, that my rage may not go forth just like a fire, and it certainly burn with no one to do the extinguishing, on account of the badness of Your dealings. (Jeremiah 4:4)
- But he is a Jew who is one on the inside, and his circumcision is that of the heart by spirit, and not by a written code. The praise of that one comes, not from men, but from God. (Romans 2:29)
- And Pharaoh proceeded to send and to call Joseph, that they might bring him quickly from the prison hole. Hence he shaved and changed his mantles and went in to Pharaoh. (Genesis 41:14)

- You must not cut your side locks short around, and you must not destroy the extremity of your beard. (Leviticus 19:27)
- Then Yehowah said to Joshua; Today I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from off You. So the name of that place came to be called Gilgal until this day. (Joshua 5:9)
- So Jonathan said to the attendant, his armor-bearer; Do come and let us cross over to the outpost of these uncircumcised men. Perhaps Yehowah will work for us, for there is no hindrance to Yehowah to save by many or by few. (1 Samuel 14:6)
- And in Moab I shall execute acts of judgment, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 25:11)
- The deaths of uncircumcised ones you will die by the hand of strangers, for I myself have spoken, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 28:10)
- And he will keep thrusting out his hand against the lands, and as regards the land of Egypt, she will not prove to be an escapee. (Daniel 11:42)
- This is what Yehowah has said, On account of three revolts of Judah, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of their rejecting the Law of Yehowah, and because they did not keep his own regulations, but their lies, after which their forefathers had walked, kept making them wander. (Amos 2:4)
