[8] - References:

- For you **have** examined us, O God; You **have** refined us as when refining silver. (**Psalms 66:10**)
- And I will turn back my hand upon you, and I shall smelt away your scummy dross as with lye, and I will remove all your waste products. (**Isaiah 1:25**)
- Look! I **have** refined you, but not in the form of silver. I **have** made choice of you in the **smelting** furnace of affliction. (**Isaiah 48:10**)
- And he must sit as a refiner and cleanser of silver and must cleanse the sons of Levi, and he must clarify them like gold and like silver, and they will certainly become to **Yehowah people** presenting a gift offering in righteousness. (**Malachi 3:3**)
- And **Yehowah** the God of their forefathers kept sending against them by means of his messengers, sending again and again, because he felt compassion for his **people** and for his dwelling. (**2 Chronicles 36:15**)
- You **have** examined my heart, you **have** made inspection by night you **have** refined me, you will discover that I **have** not schemed. My mouth will not transgress. (**Psalms 17:3**)
- The bellows **have** been scorched. Out from their fire there is lead. One **has** kept refining intensely simply for nothing, and those who are bad **have** not been separated. (**Jeremiah 6:29**)
