Ezekiel 10:18. And the glory of Yehowah proceeded to go forth from over the threshold of the house and to stand still over the cherubs.

- For this cause also you will go forth with your hands upon your head, because Yehowah has rejected the objects of your confidence, and you will have no success with them. (Jeremiah 2:37)
- I have made you a metal tester among my people, one making a thorough search, and you will take note and you must examine their way. (Jeremiah 6:27)
- All of them are the most stubborn men, walking about as slanderers, copper and iron. They are all of them ruinous. (Jeremiah 6:28)
- The bellows have been scorched. Out from their fire there is lead. One has kept refining intensely simply for nothing, and those who are bad have not been separated. (Jeremiah 6:29)
- Rejected silver is what people will certainly call them, for Yehowah has rejected them. (Jeremiah 6:30)
- And the priests were unable to stand to do their ministering because of the cloud, for the glory of Yehowah filled the house of Yehowah. (1 Kings 8:11)
- And all the sons of Israel were spectators when the fire came down and the glory of Yehowah was upon the house, and they immediately bowed low with their faces to the earth upon the pavement and prostrated themselves and thanked Yehowah, for he is good, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (2 Chronicles 7:3)
- There was something like the appearance of the bow that occurs in a cloud mass on the day of a pouring rain. That is how the appearance was of the brightness round about. It was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of Yehowah. When I got to see it, then I fell upon my face, and I began to hear the voice of one speaking. (Ezekiel 1:28)
- And as regards the glory of the God of Israel, it was taken up from over the cherubs over which it happened to be to the

threshold of the house, and he began calling out to the man that was clothed with the linen, at whose hips there was the secretary's inkhorn. (Ezekiel 9:3)

- And the glory of Yehowah proceeded to rise up from the cherubs to the threshold of the house, and the house gradually became filled with the cloud, and the courtyard itself was full of the brightness of the glory of Yehowah. (Ezekiel 10:4)
- And the glory of Yehowah went ascending from over the midst of the city and began to stand over the mountain that is to the east of the city. (Ezekiel 11:23)
