Ezekiel 11:16... Therefore say, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Although I have put them far away among the nations, and although I have scattered them among the lands, yet I shall become to them a sanctuary for a little while among the lands to which they have come.

- And that he would make their offspring fall among the nations, and that he would scatter them among the lands. (Psalms 106:27)
- And I will scatter them among the nations that neither they nor their fathers have known, and I will send after them the sword until I shall have exterminated them. (Jeremiah 9:16)
- And yet for all this, while they continue in the land of their enemies, I shall certainly not reject them nor abhor them so as to exterminate them, to violate my covenant with them, for I am Yehowah their God. (Leviticus 26:44)
- Yehowah your God must also bring back your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (Deuteronomy 30:3)
- Thus he took Jehoiachin into exile to Babylon, and the king's mother and the king's wives and his court officials and the foremost men of the land he led away as exiled people from Jerusalem to Babylon. (2 Kings 24:15)
- You give us up like sheep, as something to eat, and among the nations you have scattered us. (Psalms 44:11)
- This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Like these good figs, so I shall regard the exiles of Judah, whom I will send away from this place to the land of the Chaldeans, in a good way.

 (Jeremiah 24:5)
- For I am with you, is the utterance of Yehowah, to save you, but I shall make an extermination among all the nations to which I have scattered you. However, in your case I shall make no extermination. And I shall have to correct you to the proper

degree, as I shall by no means leave you unpunished. (Jeremiah 30:11)

- Hear the word of Yehowah, O you nations, and tell it among the islands far away, and say; The One scattering Israel will himself collect him together, and he will certainly keep him as a shepherd does his drove. (Jeremiah 31:10)
- You will conceal them in the secret place of your person from the banding together of men. You will hide them in your booth from the quarreling of tongues. (Psalms 31:20)
- O Yehowah, you yourself have proved to be a real dwelling for us during generation after generation. (Psalms 90:1)
- Because you said; Yehowah is my refuge, you have made the Most High himself your dwelling. (Psalms 91:9)
- The name of Yehowah is a strong tower. Into it the righteous runs and is given protection. (Proverbs 18:10)
