

Ezekiel 11:16 **Therefore say, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Although I have put them far away among the nations, and although I have scattered them among the lands, yet I shall become to them a sanctuary for a little while¹ among the lands to which they have come.**

[13] - References:

- And that he would make their offspring fall **among** the **nations**, and that he would scatter them **among** the **lands**. (**Psalms 106:27**)
- And I will scatter them **among** the **nations** that neither they nor their fathers **have** known, and I will send after them the sword until I shall **have** exterminated them. (**Jeremiah 9:16**)
- And yet for all this, while they continue in the land of their enemies, I shall certainly not reject them nor abhor them so as to exterminate them, to violate my covenant with them, for I am Yehowah their God. (**Leviticus 26:44**)
- Yehowah your God must also bring back your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God **has scattered** you. (**Deuteronomy 30:3**)
- Thus he took Jehoiachin into exile to Babylon, and the king's mother and the king's wives and his court officials and the foremost men of the land he led **away** as exiled people from Jerusalem to Babylon. (**2 Kings 24:15**)
- You give us up like sheep, as something to eat, and **among** the **nations** you **have scattered** us. (**Psalms 44:11**)
- This is **what** Yehowah the God of Israel **has said**; Like these good figs, so I shall regard the exiles of Judah, whom I will send **away** from this place to the land of the Chaldeans, in a good way. (**Jeremiah 24:5**)
- For I am with you, is the utterance of Yehowah, to save you, but I shall make an extermination **among** all the **nations** to which I **have scattered** you. However, in your case I shall make no extermination. And I shall **have** to correct you to the proper

- degree, as I shall by no means leave you unpunished. (**Jeremiah 30:11**)
- Hear the word of Yehowah, O **you nations**, and tell it **among** the islands **far away**, and say; The One scattering Israel will himself collect him together, and he will certainly keep him as a shepherd does his drove. (**Jeremiah 31:10**)
 - You will conceal them in the secret place of your person from the banding together of men. You will hide them in your booth from the quarreling of tongues. (**Psalms 31:20**)
 - O Yehowah, you yourself **have** proved to be a real dwelling for us during generation after generation. (**Psalms 90:1**)
 - Because you **said**; Yehowah is my refuge, you **have** made the Most High himself your dwelling. (**Psalms 91:9**)
