

**Ezekiel 11:20** **In order that they may walk in my own statutes and keep my own judicial decisions and actually carry them out, and they may really become my people and I myself may become their God.**

[13] - References:

- Subject yourselves, therefore, to **God**, but oppose the Devil, and he will flee from **you**. (**James 4:7**)
- Draw close to **God**, and he will draw close to **you**. Cleanse **YOUR** hands, **you** sinners, and purify **YOUR** hearts, **you** indecisive ones. (**James 4:8**)
- Give way to misery and mourn and weep. Let **YOUR** laughter be turned into mourning, and **YOUR** joy into dejection. (**James 4:9**)
- Humble yourselves in the eyes of Yehowah, and he will exalt **you**. (**James 4:10**)
- To the end that they might **keep** his regulations and observe his **own** laws. Praise Yah, **you people!** (**Psalms 105:45**)
- Which I commanded **YOUR** forefathers in the day of my bringing them **out** of the land of Egypt, **out** of the furnace of iron, saying; Obey my voice, and **you** must do things according to all that I command **you**, and **you** will certainly **become** my **people** and I myself shall **become** **YOUR God**. (**Jeremiah 11:4**)
- In order that those of the house of Israel may no more go wandering off from following me and may no more go defiling themselves with all their transgressions. And they must **become** my **people** and I myself shall **become** their God, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 14:11**)
- And I shall indeed **walk** in the midst of **you** and prove myself **YOUR God**, and **you**, on **YOUR** part, will prove yourselves my **people**. (**Leviticus 26:12**)
- And now, O Israel, what is Yehowah your **God** asking of you but to fear Yehowah your **God**, so as to **walk** in all his ways and to love him and to serve Yehowah your **God** with all your heart and all your soul. (**Deuteronomy 10:12**)

- For if **you** strictly **keep** all this commandment that I am commanding **you** so as to do it, to love Yehowah **YOUR God**, to **walk** in all his ways and to cling to him. (**Deuteronomy 11:22**)
- And **you** will certainly **become** my **people**, and I myself shall **become YOUR God**. (**Jeremiah 30:22**)
- And my spirit I shall put inside **you**, and I will act so that in my regulations **you** will **walk**, and my **judicial decisions** **you** will **keep** and **actually carry out**. (**Ezekiel 36:27**)
- And **you** will certainly dwell in the land that I gave to **YOUR** forefathers, and **you** must **become** my **people** and I myself shall **become YOUR God**. (**Ezekiel 36:28**)
- And my tabernacle will **actually** prove to be over them, and I shall certainly **become** their **God**, and they themselves will **become** my **people**. (**Ezekiel 37:27**)
- And if they **actually** feel humiliated because of all that they have done, the ground plan of the House, and its arrangement and its exits and its entryways, and all its ground plans and all its specifications, and all its ground plans and all its laws do you make known to them and write before their eyes, in order that they may observe all its ground plan and all its specifications and may **actually carry** them **out**. (**Ezekiel 43:11**)
- And I shall certainly bring them in, and they must reside in the midst of Jerusalem, and they must **become** my **people**, and I myself shall **become** their **God** in trueness and in righteousness. (**Zechariah 8:8**)
