Ezekiel 11:25... And I began to speak to the exiled people all the things of Yehowah that he had caused me to see.

- And after that it must occur that I shall pour out my spirit on every sort of flesh, and YOUR sons and YOUR daughters will certainly prophesy. As for YOUR old men, dreams they will dream. As for YOUR young men, visions they will see. (Joel 2:28)
- And even on the menservants and on the maidservants in those days I shall pour out my spirit. (Joel 2:29)
- And I will give portents in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and columns of smoke. (Joel 2:30)
- The sun itself will be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the coming of the great and fear-inspiring day of Yehowah. (Joel 2:31)
- And it must occur that everyone who calls on the name of Yehowah will get away safe, for in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there will prove to be the escaped ones, just as Yehowah has said, and in among the survivors, whom Yehowah is calling. (Joel 2:32)
- And in the last days, God says, I shall pour out some of my spirit upon every sort of flesh, and Your sons and Your daughters will prophesy and Your young men will see visions and Your old men will dream dreams. (Acts of Apostles 2:17)
- And even upon my men slaves and upon my women slaves I will pour out some of my spirit in those days, and they will prophesy. (Acts of Apostles 2:18)
- And I will give portents in heaven above and signs on earth below, blood and fire and smoke mist. (Acts of Apostles 2:19)
- The sun will be turned into darkness and the moon into blood before the great and illustrious day of Yehowah arrives. (Acts of Apostles 2:20)
- And everyone who calls on the name of Yehowah will be saved. (Acts of Apostles 2:21)

- And they should not become like their forefathers, a generation stubborn and rebellious, a generation who had not prepared their heart and whose spirit was not trustworthy with God. (Psalms 78:8)
- And you must speak my words to them, regardless of whether they hear or they refrain, for they are a case of rebellion. (Ezekiel 2:7)
