[14] - References:

- O God, with our ears we **have** heard, our forefather themselves **have** recounted to us the activity that you performed in their days, in the days of long ago. (**Psalms 44:1**)
- And when it occurs I **will** let **you have** as a remnant the ones escaping from the **sword among the nations**, when **you** get scattered **among** the lands. (**Ezekiel 6:8**)
- And I shall certainly make her that was limping a remnant, and her that was removed far off a mighty nation, and Yehowah **will** actually rule as king over them in Mount Zion, from now on and into time indefinite. (**Micah 4:7**)
- Unless Yehowah of armies himself had left **remaining** to us just a **few** survivors, we should **have** become just like Sodom, we should **have** resembled Gomorrah itself. (**Isaiah 1:9**)
- For although your people, O Israel, would prove to be like the grains of sand of the sea, a mere remnant **among** them **will** return. An extermination decided upon **will** be flooding through in righteousness. (**Isaiah 10:22**)
- And when it occurs I **will** let **you have** as a remnant the ones escaping from the **sword among the nations**, when **you** get scattered **among** the lands. (**Ezekiel 6:8**)
- Moreover, Isaiah cries out concerning Israel; Although the number of the sons of Israel may be as the sand of the sea, it is the remnant that **will** be saved. (**Romans 9:27**)
- Finally Yehowah was no longer able to put up with it because of the badness of **YOUR** dealings, because of the **detestable things** that **you** had done, and so **YOUR** land came to be a devastated place and an object of astonishment and a malediction, without an inhabitant, as at this day. (**Jeremiah 44:22**)

- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Clap your hands and stamp with your foot, and say; Alas! On account of all the bad **detestable things** of the house of Israel, because by the **sword**, by the **famine** and by the **pestilence** they **will** fall. (**Ezekiel 6:11**)
- Now the end is upon you, and I **must** send my anger against you, and I **will** judge you according to your ways and bring upon you all your **detestable things**. (**Ezekiel 7:3**)
- And they **will have** to **know** that I **am** Yehowah when I make the land a desolate waste, even a desolation, on account of all their **detestable things** that they **have** done. (**Ezekiel 33:29**)
- Yet I, for my part, proceeded to walk in opposition to them, and I had to bring them into the land of their enemies. Perhaps at that time their uncircumcised heart **will** be humbled, and at that time they **will** pay off their error. (**Leviticus 26:41**)
- A thousand **will** tremble on account of the rebuke of one, on account of the rebuke of five **you will** flee until **you will have** remained over like a mast on the top of a mountain and like a signal on a hill. (**Isaiah 30:17**)
- And **YOUR** escaped ones **will** certainly remember me **among** the **nations** to which they **will have** been taken captive, because I **have** been broken up at their fornicating heart that has turned aside from me and at their eyes that are going in fornication after their dungy idols, and they **will** certainly feel a loathing in their faces at the bad **things** that they **have** done in all their **detestable things**. (**Ezekiel 6:9**)
