

Ezekiel 12:17 And the word of Yehowah continued to occur to me, saying;

[3] - References:

- Let **YOUR** loins be girded and **YOUR** lamps be burning. (**Luke 12:35**)
- And **YOU** yourselves be like men waiting for their master when he returns from the marriage, so that at his arriving and knocking they may at once open to him. (**Luke 12:36**)
- Happy are those slaves whom the master on arriving finds watching! Truly I say to **you**, He will gird himself and make them recline at the table and will come alongside and minister to them. (**Luke 12:37**)
- And if he arrives in the second watch, even if in the third, and finds them thus, happy are they! (**Luke 12:38**)
- But know this, that if the householder had known at what hour the thief would come, he would have kept watching and not have let his house be broken into. (**Luke 12:39**)
- **You** also, keep ready, because at an hour that **you** do not think likely the Son of man is coming. (**Luke 12:40**)
- One thing I have asked from Yehowah; It is what I shall look for, that I may dwell in the house of Yehowah all the days of my life, to behold the pleasantness of Yehowah and to look with appreciation upon his temple. (**Psalms 27:4**)
- For he will hide me in his covert in the day of calamity, he will conceal me in the secret place of his tent, high on a rock he will put me. (**Psalms 27:5**)
- To you I have raised my eyes, O You who are dwelling in the heavens. (**Psalms 123:1**)
- Look! As the eyes of servants are toward the hand of their master, as the eyes of a maidservant are toward the hand of her mistress, so our eyes are toward Yehowah our God until he shows us favor. (**Psalms 123:2**)
- Show us favor, O Yehowah, show us favor, for to an abundance we have been gluttoned with contempt. (**Psalms 123:3**)

- **Abundantly our soul has been glutted with the derision of those who are at ease, of the contempt on the part of the arrogant ones. (Psalms 123:4)**
