- And Ezekiel has become for **you** a **portent**. In accord with all that he has done, **you will** do. When it comes, **you will** also **have** to know that I am the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 24:24**)
- In that day your mouth **will** be opened to the escaped one, and you **will** speak and be mute no longer, and you **will** certainly become to them a **portent**, and they **will have** to know that I am Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 24:27**)
- And Ezekiel has become for **you** a **portent**. In accord with all that he has done, **you will** do. When it comes, **you will** also **have** to know that I am the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 24:24**)
- Look! I and the children whom Yehowah has given me are as signs and as miracles in **Israel** from Yehowah of armies, who is residing in Mount Zion. (**Isaiah 8:18**)
- And as for you, take to yourself an iron griddle, and you must put it as an iron wall between you and the city, and you must fix your **face** against it, and it must get to be in a siege, and you must besiege it. It is a sign to the **house** of **Israel**. (**Ezekiel 4:3**)
- As for you, O son of man, make up for yourself luggage for exile and go into exile in the daytime before their **eyes**, and you must go into exile from your place to another place before their **eyes**. Perhaps they **will see**, though they are a rebellious **house**. (**Ezekiel 12:3**)
