- **Woe to **you**, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! Because **you** resemble whitewashed graves, which outwardly indeed appear beautiful but inside are full of dead men's bones and of every sort of uncleanness. (Matthew 23:27)**
- **In that way **you** also, outwardly indeed, appear righteous to **men**, but inside **you** are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness. (Matthew 23:28)**
- **Then Paul **said** to him; God is going to strike you, you whitewashed **wall**. Do you at one and the same time sit to judge me in accord with the Law and, transgressing the Law, command me to be struck? (Acts of Apostles 23:3)**
- **For in it God's righteousness is being revealed by reason of faith and toward faith, just as it is written: But the righteous one, by means of faith he will live. (Romans 1:17)**
- **For God's wrath is being revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of **men** who are suppressing the truth in an unrighteous way. (Romans 1:18)**
- **Where, now, are **YOUR** prophets who prophesied to **you**, saying; The king of Babylon will not come against **you men** and against this land? (Jeremiah 37:19)**
